


#BLUEBERRYCLUTCH

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blueberry clutch

ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s) = Stitch(es)
k = Knit
p = Purl
rnd = Round
patt = Pattern
dec = Decrease(s)
st st = Stocking stitch

p2tog = P 2 sts together
p3tog = P 3 sts together
WS = Wrong side
beg = Beginning
rep = Repeat
cont = Continue

The clutch is worked bottom up on circular needles. Dec are worked at the top edge since st st is wider than trinity st.

INSTRUCTIONS:

On the size 7, 40 cm circular needles cast on 96 sts. Place a marker at the beg of the round. The entire clutch is worked from the WS.

Round 1: *[k1, p1, k1] in the same st, p3tog* rep from * to * to the last st of the round.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: *p3tog, [k1, p1, k1] in the same st* rep from * to * to the last st of the round.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 1-4 creates the trinity st patt. Cont in st patt until the work measures 12,5 cm. Now work the edge. First dec as follows: *p6, p2tog* rep from * to * the entire round. 84 sts remain. Purl [reverse st st] until the work measures approx. 15,5 cm. Cast off all sts.

FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and block lightly. Fold the st st edge in the middle [knit side out] and seam it on the WS along the border between st st and trinity st patt.


LINING:

Measure the width and length of the clutch, cut 2 pieces of fabric with these measurements:


Width + 2 cm and length + 2 cm.

Example: If the width is 23 cm and the length is 13 cm cut he pieces 25 cm x 15 cm.

Sew the zipper on the fabric.



Baste the zipper on both sides with 0,5 cm sts.



Sew together the lining at both ends and bottom, sew as close to the zipper as possible.

Sew the lining into the clutch by hand with small invisible sts.

Seam the bottom of the clutch.

MEASUREMENTS

23 cm x 13 cm

YARN

Hooked Fraya
 70% Cotton + 30% Polyamide
 50 g = 90 m

YARDAGE

100 g

GAUGE

In trinity st patt
 20 sts x 24 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Circular needle 40 cm
 UK 7 [4½ mm]

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

St marker, zipper, 25 cm,
 approx. 20 cm of fabric lining
