## MUSHROOM:

## Bottom and stalk

Preferably crocheted in a light co.
Leave an approx. 50 cm long yarn end to embroider spots with.
Work 3 cs, connect to make a ring with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 1 cs , work 6 db in the ring.
Round 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3-4: 1 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: *1 db in the first db , crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the entire round $=8 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6-7: 1 db in each $\mathrm{db}=8 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9: 2 db in every second $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
1 sls in the next st.

## Top:

Crochet in a different co.
Work 3 cs, connect to make a ring with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 1 cs, work 6 db in the ring.
Round 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: 2 db in every second $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: 1 db in each $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 2 db in every third $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: 1 db in each $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: Crochet top and bottom of the mushroom tog, work 1 db where you work through 1 db from the top and 1 db from the bottom with all 24 sts - before you finish the round fill with fiber filling.
With the end hanging from the top work 8 cs , work a sls around the bottom part of the chain so that the mushroom is attached to the chain. Work 8 cs back. Weave in the end neatly.

## BALL:

Work 3 cs , connect to make a ring with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring.
Round 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: *1 db in the first $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db * rep from * to * the entire round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db} *$ rep from * to * the entire round $=24 \mathrm{~d}$
Round 5-8: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9: *1 db in the first 2 db , crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the entire round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 10: *1 db in the first db , crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the entire round $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 11: Crochet 2 db tog the entire round $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Work 1 round where you crochet 2 db tog twice $=4 \mathrm{db}$.
Work 8 cs , find the middle of the chain and work a sls around the bottom part of the chain so that the ball is attached to the chain. Work 8 sls back. Weave in the end neatly.

Colourful Fraya
100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=170 \mathrm{~m}$
or
Shiny Fraya
66\% Viscose + 34\% Polyester
$25 \mathrm{~g}=125 \mathrm{~m}$

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE
Size $2,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ [UK size 12/13] crochet hook
