

#SQUEEZY PUMPKIN

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ABBREVIATIONS:**st(s)** = stitch(es)**k** = knit**p** = purl**k2tog** = knit 2 sts together**k3tog** = knit 3 sts together**p2tog** = purl 2 sts together**inc** = increase(s), pick up the thread between 2 sts and knit or purl it through the back loop**dec** = decrease(s)**cont** = continue**Co** = colour

Worked back and forth with 2 strands of yarn. The pumpkin is seamed at the side.

SMALL PUMPKIN/BIG PUMPKIN:

With 2 strands of yarn cast on 20 [30] sts on the size 4,0 needles with co 1. Work 3 rows of rib, k1, p1.

Inc:

Now inc 10 [15] sts, 1 in each k "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k2, p1. A total of 30/45 sts.

Now inc 10 [15] sts, 1 in each k "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k3, p1. A total of 40/60 sts.

Now inc 10 [15] sts, 1 in each p "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k3, p2. A total of 50/75 sts.

Now inc 10 [15] sts, 1 in each k "column". A total of 60/90 sts.

Middle part:

Work 9 rows of rib, k4, p2.

Dec:

Now dec 10 [15] sts, 1 in each k "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k3, p2. A total of 50/75 sts.

Now dec 10 [15] sts, 1 in each p "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k3, p1. A total of 40/60 sts.

Now dec 10 [15] sts, 1 in each k "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k2, p1. A total of 30/45 sts.

Now dec 10 [15] sts, 1 in each k "column". Work 3 rows of rib, k1, p1. A total of 20/30 sts.

STALK:

Switch to co 2 and two double pointed needles.

K2tog across the entire row. P 1 row. A total of 10/15 sts.

K2tog [k3tog] the entire row. P 1 row. A total of 5 sts.

K the entire row. All the sts are now on the right needle. Switch this needle to the left hand and pull the yarn to the front of the needle [across the back]. Now k the row.

In this way you will knit a stalk in the round. Cont until the stalk is approx. 3 cm, cast off all sts.

Weave in the ends and seam along the side. Fill with filling before closing it all the way. Done.

Reliable Fraya

70% Wool + 30% Polyamide

50 g = 150 m

or

Steady Fraya

70% Wool + 30% Polyamide

50 g = 150 m

YARDAGE

Co. 1 = 50 g

Co. 2 = 100 g

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Size 4,0 mm [UK size 8] needles,

size 4,0 double pointed needles

Fibre filling
