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ABBREVIATIONS:**st(s)** = stitch(es)**k** = knit**p** = purl**patt** = pattern**st st** = stocking stitch**yo** = yarn over**tog** = together**tbl** = through the back loop**beg** = beginning**rep** = repeat**cont** = continue**rem** = remaining**RS** = right side**WS** = wrong side**co** = colour**mrk** = marker**inc** = increase**dec** = decrease**col** = colour

The entire sweater is knit with two strands of yarn.

FRONT AND BACK:

On the UK size 10-9 [3½ mm] needles cast on 128 [136] 144 [150] 156 [164] 172 sts on the circular needle with co 1 and 2 strands of yarn.

Work 3 [3] 3 [3,5] 3,5 [4] 4 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Switch to UK size 8 [4 mm] circular needles and st st. On the first round evenly inc to 134 [142] 150 [158] 166 [174] 182 sts. Place a mrk thread at the beg of the round and after 67 [71] 75 [79] 83 [87] 91 sts (side), let the marker thread follow up through the work.

Work in st st until the work measures 23 [24] 25 [27] 30 [32] 34 cm.

Now cast off 3 [3] 3 [4] 4 [4] 4 sts on both sides of the marker thread for the armhole. You now have 61 [65] 69 [71] 75 [79] 83 sts on the front and back. Place a mrk thread at the middle st. Let the work rest.

SLEEVE:

On the UK size 10-9 [3½ mm] double pointed needles cast on 32 [32] 36 [36] 40 [40] 44 sts with co 1 and 2 strands of yarn.

Work 3 [3] 3 [3,5] 3,5 [4] 4 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Switch to UK size 8 [4 mm] double pointed needles and st st. On the first round evenly inc to 38 [38] 42 [44] 48 [48] 52 sts.

K 4 rounds.

Inc 1 st at the beg and the end of the round.

Inc on every 4th [5th] 6th [6th] 5th [6th] 6th round a total of 11 [11] 11 [12] 15 [15] 15 times, you now have a total of 60 [60] 64 [68] 78 [78] 82 sts on the round.

Work even until the work measures 22 [26] 29 [31] 34 [38] 41 cm.

Cast off 3 [3] 3 [4] 4 [4] 4 sts at the beg and end of the round for the armhole.

Let the work rest.

Knit another sleeve in the same way.

YARN

Mindful Fraya

100% Wool

50 g = 350 m

YARDAGE

Col. 1: 200 g

Col. 2: 50 g

Col. 3: 50 g

Col. 4: 50 g

Col. 5: 50 g

GAUGE

20 sts and 28 rows to 10 x 10 cm in st st on size 4 mm needles with two strands of yarn

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 10-9 and 8 [3½ and 4 mm], 60 cm circular needles and double pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

Place all parts on the circular needles, first knit one sleeve on to the circular needles, then knit the front, then knit the other sleeve on to the circular needle, then knit the back. Please a mrk thread at the beg of the round.

You now have a total of 230 [238] 254 [262] 290 [298] 314 sts on the round.

Place a mrk thread at the middle st of the front and back.

When working dec do not work dec across the middle st of the front and back.

YOKE SIZES 104 (110):

Work 2 rounds.

Work 1 round while evenly dec 2 [10] sts, you now have 228 sts left.

Work 0 [2] rounds without dec.

Work patt 1 according to chart, count so that the point of the pattern lines up with the middle st of the front and back.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 210 sts left.

Work patt 2 according to chart, count from the middle so that the star lines up with the middle st on the front and back.

You now have 182 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 14 sts. You now have 168 sts left.

Work patt 3 according to chart while at the same time dec 12 sts on the 1st round. You now have 156 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 12 sts. You now have 144 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 14 sts. You now have 130 sts left.

Work patt 1 according to chart while at the same time dec 10 sts on the 1st round. You now have 120 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 20 sts. You now have 100 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart while at the same time dec 20 sts on the 1st round. You now have 80 sts left.

Work 1 round with co 1.

Switch to UK size 10-9 [3½ mm] needles and work 8 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Cast off the sts very loosely.

YOKE SIZES 122 (128):

Work 6 rounds.

Work 1 round while evenly dec 2 [10] sts, you now have 252 sts left.

Work 1 [3] round[s] without dec.

Work patt 1 according to chart, count so that the point of the pattern lines up with the middle st of the front and back.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 12 sts. You now have 240 sts left.

Work patt 2 according to chart, count from the middle so that the star lines up with the middle st on the front and back.

You now have 208 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 16 sts. You now have 192 sts left.

Work patt 3 according to chart while at the same time dec 12 sts on the 1st round. You now have 180 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 16 sts. You now have 164 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 16 sts. You now have 148 sts left.

Work patt 1 according to chart while at the same time dec 22 sts on the 1st round. You now have 126 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 108 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart while at the same time dec 18 sts on the 1st round. You now have 90 sts left.

Work 1 round with co 1.

Switch to UK size 10-9 [3½ mm] needles and work 8 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Cast off the sts very loosely.

YOKE SIZES 140 (152):

Work 1 round.

Work 1 round while evenly dec 2 [10] sts, you now have 288 sts left.

Work 2 [4] rounds without dec.

Work patt 1 according to chart, count so that the point of the pattern lines up with the middle st of the front and back.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 270 sts left.

Work patt 2 according to chart, count from the middle so that the star lines up with the middle st on the front and back.

You now have 234 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 216 sts left.

Work patt 3 according to chart while at the same time dec 12 sts on the 1st round. You now have



204 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 186 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 168 sts left.

Work patt 1 according to chart while at the same time dec 12 sts on the 1st round. You now have 156 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 12 sts. You now have 144 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 2nd round evenly dec 16 sts. You now have 132 sts left.

Work patt 3 according to chart.

Work 1 round with co 1 while evenly dec 22 sts. You now have 110 sts left.

Switch to size 3.5 mm needles and work 9 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Cast off the sts very loosely.

YOKE SIZE 158:

Work 4 rounds.

Work 1 round while evenly dec 2 sts, you now have 312 sts left.

Work 4 rounds without dec.

Work patt 1 according to chart, count so that the point of the pattern lines up with the middle st of the front and back.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 12 sts. You now have 300 sts left.

Work patt 2 according to chart, count from the middle so that the star lines up with the middle st on the front and back.

You now have 260 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 20 sts. You now have 240 sts left.

Work patt 3 according to chart while at the same time dec 12 sts on the 1st round. You now have 288 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 20 sts. You now have 208 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 22 sts. You now have 186 sts left.

Work patt 1 according to chart.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 18 sts. You now have 168 sts left.

Work patt 4 according to chart while on the 1st round evenly dec 12 sts. You now have 156 sts left.

Work 2 rounds with co 1 while on the 1st round evenly dec 12 sts. You now have 144 sts left.

Work patt 3 according to chart.

Work 1 round with co 1 while evenly dec 24 sts. You now have 120 sts left.

Switch to UK size 10-9 [3½ mm] needles and work 9 cm of rib, k1, p1.

Cast off the sts very loosely.

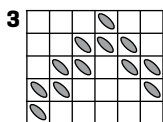
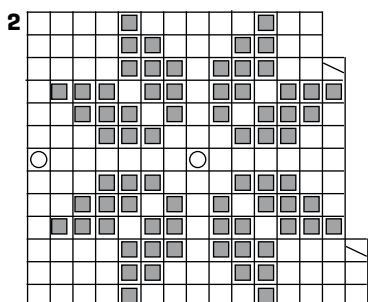
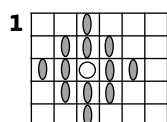
FINISHING:

Weave in the ends.

Sew the holes under the arms with invisible sts.

Fold the neck rib double and sew it to the WS. Careful not to sew too tightly.

Rinse the sweater in tepid water, pull it into shape and let it dry.
