

when all else fails

ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s) = stitch(es) tbl = through the back loop = beginning k = knit beg = purl = repeat rep patt = pattern cont = continue = marker RS = riaht side mrk = stocking stitch WS = wrong side st st = increase(s) yo = varn over inc = together = decrease(s) tog dec

BODY:

On the UK size 13-12 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ mm), 60 cm circular needle cast on 148 (152) 168 (176) 192 sts. Place a mrk on every side with 74 (76) 84 (88) 96 sts for each side. Work 6 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Switch to the UK size 11 (3 mm), 60 cm circular needles.

Work in st st until the work measures 18 (22) 23 (24) 25 cm. Now cast off 6 sts on each side for the sleeve; i.e. 3 sts on each side of the mrks. You now have 68 (76) 78 (82) 90 on the front/back. Let the work rest.

SLEEVES:

On the UK size 13-12 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ mm) double pointed needles cast on 38 (40) 42 (46) 50 sts. Place a mrk at the beg of the round

Work 6 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Switch to the UK size 11 (3 mm) double pointed needles.

Work in st st and at the same time inc 1 st on each side of the mrk on every 6th (6th) 6th (8th) round until you have a total of 50 (54) 60 (64) 68 sts. Cont working even until the work measures 18 (20) 22 (26) 29 cm. Cast off 3 sts on each side of the mrk and let the work rest.

Knit another sleeve in the same way.

YOKE:

Place all the parts on UK size 11 (3 mm), 60 cm circular needle and place a mrk between every part. Front and back: 68 (70) 78 (82) 90 sts, sleeves: 44 (48) 54 (58) 62 sts. Cont working in st st and work dec by dec 1 st before and 1 st after the mrk as follows.

Round 1: K.

Round 2: K and work dec.

Round 3: K.

Round 4: K and work dec.

Round 5: K.

Round 6: K.

Round 7: K and work dec.

In this way you dec 24 sts on every 7th round. Rep this 5 (6) 6 (6) 7 times until 80 (80) 96 (112) 112 sts rem. **Sizes 86 (92) 104:** Work 3 extra rounds. Change to the UK size 13-12 (2½ mm), double pointed needles and work 6 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Cast off all sts.

Sizes (110) 122: Work 4 extra rounds where you dec on every 2nd round. Change to the UK size 13-12 (2½ mm), double pointed needles and work 6 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Cast off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block lightly. Seam the sleeves.

SIZES

86 (92) 104 (110) 122

MEASUREMENTS

Chest ½: 28 (29) 32 (34) 37 cm Length: 32 (34) 36 (41) 44 cm

YARN

Steady Fraya 70% Wool + 30% Polyamide 50 g = 150 m

YARDAGE

150 (200) 200 (200) 250 g

GAUGE

25 sts and 36 rows to 10 x 10 cm in st st on UK size 11 (3 mm) needles

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 13-12 and 11 (2½ and 3 mm), 60 circular needles, UK size 13-12 and 11 (2½ and 3 mm) double pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
