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ABBREVIATIONS:

st[s] = stitch[es] k = knit = purl p tbl = through the back loop toa = together = right side RS ws = wrong side = beginning bea = repeat rep

- **rem** = remain(ing)
- **st st** = stocking st

The sweater is worked top down.

<u>Pattern:</u>

Cast on 68 (68) 68 sts on UK size 7 (4.5 mm) double pointed needles for Merry Fraya or UK size 11 (3 mm) for Honest Fraya.

Place a mrk at the beg of the round. Work in rib, k1, p1 the first 5 sts, place a mrk, work round 1 of the chart (back) 29 sts, place a mrk, work in rib, k1, p1 the next 5 sts, place a mrk, work round 1 of the chart (front) 29 sts.

Round 2-4: Work in patt.

Round 5: *k1, inc, k3, inc, k1, mrk, work round 5 of the chart, mrk*, rep from * to * one more time. **Round 6:** Work in patt, k all the yo's.

Round 7: *k1, inc, k5, inc, k1, mrk, work round 5 of the chart, mrk*, rep from * to * one more time. **Round 8:** Work in patt, k all the yo's.

Round 9: Cont by inc on each side of the sleeves on every other round and at the same time work chart on front and back.

At round 11 change to UK size 5 (5.5 mm) needles for Merry Fraya and UK size 8 (4 mm) for Honest Fraya.

Cont inc on each side of the sleeves on every second round and at the same time work chart on front and back.

On round 23 work bobbles on the sleeves as follows: K1, 1 inc, k5, bobble, k9, bobble, k5, 1 inc, k1, mrk, work chart, k1, 1 inc, k5, bobble, k9, bobble, k5, 1 inc, k1, marker, work chart.

When the chart has been worked, there are 45 [49] 49 sts on the front and back and 33 [35] 35 sts on the sleeves.

Sizes (116/122) 134/140:

Cont working inc on the sleeves and on the front and back in st st with bobbles on every 10th round with 9 sts in between as shown in the chart.

Work this way for the next [6] 16 rounds until you have [55] 65 sts on the front and back [43] 53 sts on the sleeves.

All sizes:

Now divide for body and sleeves so that the front and back are worked together and the sleeves

YARN

Merry Fraya 100% Merino Wool 50 g = 100 m or Honest Fraya 100% Cotton 50 q = 75 m

YARDAGE Merry Fraya 200 (300) 400

Honest Fraya 300 (350) 400

GAUGE

Merry Fraya In st st on UK size 5 (5.5 mm) needles: 16 sts x 24 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

Honest Fraya In st st on UK size 4 (8 mm) needles: 16 sts x 24 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Merry Fraya: Size 7 and 5 (4½ and 5½ mm) 60 cm circular and double pointed needles

Honest Fraya: Size 11 and 8 (3 and 4 mm) 60 cm circular and double pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS Stitch markers

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- mrk = marker patt = pattern
- dec = decrease(s), k2tog or k2togtbl
- inc = increase(s), pick up the yarn between two sts and k it tbl.
- cont = continue
- **bobble** = (k1, p1, p1, k1) in the same st, turn the work, p4, turn the work, k4, pull the second, third and fourth st over the first st. You now have a bobble.

after. Work across the sts of the back, place the sts for the sleeves on a string, cast on 5 [5] 5 sts, work across the sts of the front, place the sts for the sleeves on a string, cast on 5 [5] 5 sts. Cont in st st and with bobbles evenly spaced as described until the work measures 30 [39] 46 cm. Change to the UK size 7 [4.5 mm] circular needles for Merry Fraya or UK size 11 [3 mm] for Honest Fraya and work 4 cm of rib, k1, p1, and cast off all sts loosely.

Sleeves:


Place the sleeve sts on UK size 5 (5.5 mm) needles for Merry Fraya and UK size 8 (4 mm) for Honest Fraya.

Pick up 5 [5] 5 sts in the armhole and place a mrk to mark the beg of the round. You now have 38 [48] 58 sts. Cont in st st and with bobbles as shown in the chart with 9 sts in between and on every 10th round. Dec 1 sts on each side of marker every 8th round until 28 [32] 32 sts rem and the work measures 34 [42] 54 cm from the neck opening. Change to the UK size 7 [4.5 mm] double pointed needles for Merry Fraya or UK size 11 [3 mm] for Honest Fraya and work 4 cm of rib, k1, p1, and cast off all sts loosely.

Tip: The inc on the yoke are worked on the front and back and sleeves 1 st before the mrk and 1 st after the marker so that there are 2 sts between each inc.

Finishing:

Press lightly and weave in all ends.
