

#PRETTYPLEASESWEATER

pretty please sweater

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ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit
p = purl
tbl = through the back loop
tog = together
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
beg = beginning
rep = repeat
rem = remain(ing)

st st = stocking st
cont = continue
mrk = marker
patt = pattern
inc = increase[s] pick up the yarn between 2 sts and k it tbl
dec = decrease[s] on the right side of the mrk: k2tog, on the left side of the mrk: k2togtbl
2 inc = k 2 in the yarn between two sts

Eyelet patt mid front and mid back (8 sts in all):

Round 1: K1, k2tog, yo, k2, yo, k2togtbl, k1.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: K2tog, yo, k4, yo, k2togtbl.

Round 4: Knit.

The sweater is worked top down.

NECK OPENING:

Cast on 104 [104] 104 [112] 112 sts on the UK size 13-12 [2.5 mm] double pointed needles. Place a mrk at the beg of the round and work in rib, k2, p2, until the work measures 2 cm. Change to the UK size 12-10 [3 mm] double pointed needles. Divide the sts using mrks.

K 1 round and place a mrk after 50 [50] 50 [54] 54 sts [back], after 2 sts [sleeve], after 50 [50] 50 [54] 54 sts [front], after 2 sts [sleeve].

Yoke:

Round 1: *K1, 1 inc, k20 [20] 20 [22] 22, work in eyelet patt for the next 8 sts, k20 [20] 20 [22] 22, 1 inc, k1, work to the mrk, k1, 2 inc, k1, work to the marker*. Rep from * to * one more time.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: *K22 [22] 22 [24] 24, work in eyelet patt across the next 8 sts, k22 [22] 22 [24] 24, work to the mrk, k1, 1 inc, k2, 1 inc, k1, work to the mrk*. Rep from to * one more time.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: *K22 [22] 22 [24] 24, work in eyelet patt across the next 8 sts, k22 [22] 22 [24] 24, work to the mrk, k1, 1 inc, k4, 1 inc, k1, work to the mrk*. Rep from to * one more time.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: *K22 [22] 22 [24] 24, work in eyelet patt across the next 8 sts, k22 [22] 22 [24] 24, work to the mrk, k1, 1 inc, k6, 1 inc, k1, work to the mrk*. Rep from to * one more time.

Round 8: Knit.

Now dec on both sides of front and back on every 8th round and on both sides of both sleeves on every second round until you have 62 [62] 62 [68] 68 sts for the front and back and 50 [50] 50 [58] 58 sts for the sleeves

Now dec on both sides of front and back and both sides of sleeves - on every second round a total of

½ Chest cm:
 29 [32] 33 [34] 36

YARN

Lovely Fraya
 100% Merino Wool
 50 g = 180 m

YARDAGE

200 [200] 250 [250] 300 g

GAUGE

In st st on UK size 12-10 [3 mm] needles:
 26 sts x 38 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 12-10 (3 mm) 60 cm circular needles, UK size 13-12 and 12-10 (2½ and 3 mm) double pointed needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

Stitch markers

5 [8] 10 [9] 11 times until you have 72 [78] 82 [84] 90 sts for the front and back and 60 [66] 70 [76] 80 sts for the sleeves.

FRONT AND BACK:

Now divide the work so that the front and back are worked tog and the sleeves separately. Cont the eyelet patt on the middle of the front and back.

Work the sts for the back, place the sleeve sts on a st holder, cast on 4 new sts and place a mrk in the middle of these, work the sts of the front, place the sts of the sleeve on a st holder, cast on 4 new sts and place a mrk in the middle of these, that marks the beg of the round.

Work across the sts of the front and back until the work measures 35 [37] 39 [42] 45 cm.

Change to the UK size 13-12 [2.5 mm] circular needle, 60 cm and work 2 cm of rib, k2, p2.

Cast off all sts loosely.

SLEEVE:

Place the 60 [66] 70 [76] 80 sts of the sleeve on UK size 12-10 [3 mm] double pointed needles and pick up 4 sts under the sleeve so that you have 64 [70] 74 [80] 84 sts. Place a mrk in the middle of the 4 new sts.

Work in st st and dec 1 st on each side of the mrk on every 7th [6th] 6th [6th] 6th round a total of 10 [13] 15 [16] 18 times until 44 [44] 44 [48] 48 sts rem. Cont until the sleeve measures 22 [24] 26 [28] 30 cm measured under the armhole.

Change to UK size 13-12 [2.5 mm] double pointed needles and work 2 cm of rib, k2, p2.

Cast off all sts loosely.

RUFFLE:

Cast on 120 [128] 128 [136] 136 on the UK size 12-10 [3 mm] needle. Work 3 rows of st st starting with a WS row.

K and turn the work 4 sts before the end of the row, cont purling and turn 4 sts before the end of the row.

K and turn the work 4 sts before the last turn, cont purling and turn 4 sts before the last turn.

Cont in this way until 64 [72] 72 [80] 80 sts rem. Cut the yarn and place the sts from the left needle on the right so you are starting on the RS of the 120 [128] 128 [136] 136 sts.

K1, k3tog, rep from * to * the entire round. Cast off all sts loosely.

Knit another ruffle in the same way.

FINISHING:

Weave in the ends and press lightly.

Sew the ruffle on the sweater right under the rib of the neck and along the sleeve increases so that the middle of the ruffle fits across the shoulder. Sew on the other ruffle in the same way.
