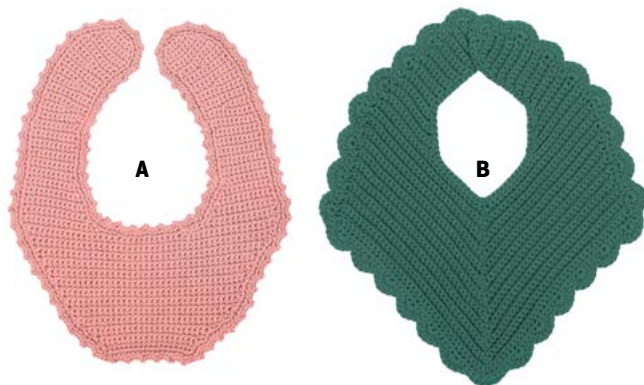

A: ROUND BIB

Using color 1, work 19 cs.

Row 1: Begin in 2nd st from hook, 18 db

Row 2: 3 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 20 db

Row 3: 3 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 22 db

Row 4: 3 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 24 db

Row 5: 3 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 26 db

Row 6: 3 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 28 db

Row 7: 3 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 30 db

Row 8: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 31 db

Row 9: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 32 db

Row 10: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 33 db

Row 11: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 34 db

Row 12: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 35 db

Row 13: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 36 db

Row 14: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 37 db

Row 15: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 38 db

Row 16: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 39 db

Row 17: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 40 db

Row 18: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 41 db

Row 19: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 42 db

Row 20: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 43 db

Row 21: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 44 db

Row 22: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 45 db

Row 23: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 46 db

Now work each side separately.

Row 24: 2 cs, begin in 2nd st from hook, 19 db

Row 25: 3 sls, 16 db

Row 26: 1 cs, 14 db

Row 27: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 12 db

Row 28: 1 cs, 13 db

Row 29: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 11 db

Row 30: 1 cs, 12 db

Row 31: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 10 db

Row 32: 1 cs, 11 db

Row 33: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 9 db

Row 34-45: 1 cs, 10 db

Row 46: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 7 db, 2 db in last st

Row 47: 1 cs, 10 db

Row 48: 1 cs, 5 db, 1 sls

YARN

Colourful Fraya

100 % Cotton

50 g = 170 m

YARDAGE

A: 50 g, left over yarn for edging

B: 50 g

CROCHET GAUGE

A: 14 fm og 15 rk = 5 cm x 5 cm

B: 13 db and 14 rows = 5 cm x 5 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

A: UK size 12 [2.5 mm] crochet hook

B: UK size 11 [3 mm] crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

NOTIONS

A & B: Snap fastener

Row 49: 1 sls, 5 db
Row 50–53: 1 cs, 10 db
Row 54: 1 cs, 5 db, 1 sls
Row 55: 1 sls, 5 db
Row 56–59: 1 cs, 10 db
Row 60: 1 cs, 5 db, 1 sls
Row 61: 1 sls, 5 db
Row 62: 1 cs, 10 db
Row 63: 1 cs, 10 db
Row 64: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 7 db, 2 db in last st
Row 65: 1 cs, 10 db
Row 66: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 8 db
Row 67: 1 cs, 9 db
Row 68: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 5 db, 2 db tog
Row 69: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 3 db, 2 db tog
Row 70: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 1 db, 2 db tog

Crochet db around the entire bib, 1 db in every st and 1 db in every row.

Change to color 2, work a round of picots as follows:

3 db, 2 cs, 1 db in last db, repeat from* to * around.

Weave in ends, sew on a large snap to fasten the bib.

B: POINTY BIB WITH SHELL EDGING

Work every db in the back loop only.

Work 80 cs.

Row 1: 79 db, beginning in 2nd st from hook

Row 2: 1 cs, 2 db in 1st st, 37 db, 3 db tog = the 3 middle sts [place a marker if needed], 37 db, 2 db in last st

Row 3: 1 cs, work db until the 3 middle sts, 3 db tog, work db to the end of the row

Row 4: 1 cs, 2 db in 1st st, work db until the 3 middle sts, 3 db tog, work db to the end of the row, ending with 2 db in last st

Repeat row 3 and 4 a total of 9 times.

Now repeat row 3 until a total of 23 rows have been worked.

Now work each side separately.

Row 24: 1 cs, 15 db, turn

Row 25: 1 sls, 14 db

Row 26: 1 cs, 13 db

Row 27: 1 sls, 12 db

Row 28: 1 cs, 11 db

Row 29: 1 sls, 10 db

Row 30: 1 cs, 9 db

Row 31: 1 sls, 8 db

Row 32–44: 1 cs, 8 db

Row 45: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 4 db, 2 db tog

Row 46: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 2 db, 2 db tog

Row 47: 1 cs, 2 db tog, 2 db tog, break the yarn

Work the other side in the same way – but opposite.

Crochet db around the entire bib, 1 db in every st and 1 db in every row, 2 db in the corners at the bottom of the bib.

Now crochet a shell edging as follows:

Begin at the top of the “sides” of the bib, count to place a shell in the exact middle of the bib.

1 db, skip 2 sts, 6 tr in next st, skip 2 sts, repeat from * to * until you reach the same point on the opposite side of the bib.

Weave in ends, sew on a large snap to fasten the bib.
