

# no nonsense cardigan

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

 st(s)
 = stitch(es)
 WS

 k
 = knit
 M1

 p
 = purl

 RS
 = right side

The body is worked to the armholes, then the work is split and each section is finished separately.

= wrong side

= make 1

#### **BODY**

Cast on 139 [153] 167 [177] sts and work 9 rows of k1, p1 ribbing. Start and end with p1. Work in stockinette stitch until the body measures 16 [18] 20 [23] cm. Now divide the body for fronts and back on a WS row.

Purl 33 (36) 39 (42) sts, bind off 2 sts, purl 69 (77) 85 (89) sts, bind off 2 sts, purl 33 (36) 39 (42) sts

# **RIGHT FRONT:**

Bind off sts for the armhole at the beginning of every other row. Bind off 2 sts a total of 1 (2) 2 (2) times, then bind off 1 stitch a total of 3 (2) 2 (2) times. There are now 28 (30) 33 (36) sts left on the needle

Work straight until body measures 23 [26] 29 [31] cm. Bind off sts at the neck edge at the beginning of every other row. Bind off 7 sts once, then bind off 3 sts a total of 1 [1] 1 [2] times, then 2 sts a total of 1 [1] 2 [1] times, then 1 stitch a total of 1 [2] 1 [1] times.

Work 3 [5] 5 [9] rows straight in stockinette stitch, ending at the neck edge.

Leave the remaining 15 (16) 18 (20) sts (shoulder) on a stitch holder, to be sewn together with the corresponding back shoulder using Kitchener stitch.

If the shoulder is to be sewn together: Work 2 more rows and bind off.  $\label{eq:control}$ 

### **LEFT FRONT:**

Work the same as the right front, only mirror reversed.

#### BACK:

Bind off for the armholes the same as on the fronts. After binding off, there are 59 [65] 73 [77] sts left on the needle.

Continue straight until work measures 25 [28] 31 [34] cm.

Work 16 (17) 19 (21) sts, bind off 27 (31) 35 (35) sts, work 16 (17) 19 (21) sts. Finish each side separately.

Bind off 1 stitch at the neck edge, work 5 rows in stockinette stitch. Sew the shoulder sts together with the corresponding front shoulder using Kitchener stitch.

If the shoulder is to be sewn together: Work 2 more rows and bind off.

Work the second shoulder the same as the first, only mirror reversed.

Sew the shoulder seams together.

# SIZES

56-62 (68-74) 80-86 (92) 0-3 m (6-9 m) 12-18 m (2 years)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

½ chest: 27 (30) 33 (35) cm Length from high point shoulder: 27 (31) 34 (37) cm

#### YARN

Colourful Fraya 100 % Cotton 50 g = 170 m

## YARDAGE

100 (150) 200 (250) g

#### **GAUGE**

In stockinette stitch on a UK size 11 [3 mm] needle 26 sts and 36 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

# SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 11 (3 mm) needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

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#### **LEFT FRONT EDGE:**

Pick up and knit approx. 64 [72] 80 [86] sts from the RS. Work 2 rows of k1, p1 rib.

**Row 3:** (at hem of cardigan) 4 sts in rib, \*bind off 2 sts, work 10 (12) 14 (15) sts in rib\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, bind off 2 sts, work 10 (10) 10 (12) sts in rib.

**Row 4:** Work 10 (10) 10 (12) sts in rib, \*cast on 2 new sts, work 10 (12) 14 (15) sts in rib\*, repeat from \* to \* a total of 4 times, cast on 2 new sts, work 4 sts on rib.

Work 3 more rows in rib for a total of 7 rows. Bind off.

#### **RIGHT FRONT EDGE:**

Pick up and knit approx. 64 [72] 80 [86] sts from the RS. Work 7 rows of k1, p1 rib. Bind off.

#### **NECK EDGE:**

Pick up and knit sts along the neck edge from the RS as follows: 8 sts across the front edge rib, 14 [15] 16 [19] m along right front, 29 [33] 35 [35] sts along the back, 14 [15] 16 [19] sts along the left front edge, 8 sts across front edge rib. There are now a total of 73 [79] 83 [89] sts. Work 2 rows of k1, p1 rib.

**Row 3:** Work 3 sts in rib, bind off 2 sts, work 68 [74] 78 [84] sts in rib.

**Row 4:** Work 68 [74] 78 [84] sts in rib, cast on 2 new sts, work 3 sts in rib.

Work 3 more rows in rib for a total of 7 rows. Bind off.

#### SLEEVE:

Cast on 38 [40] 42 [46] sts and work 9 rows of k1, p1 rib.

Now work in stockinette stitch, while increasing 7 (9) 11 (13) sts evenly across the first row. There are now a total of 45 (49) 53 (59) sts on the needle.

Continue in stockinette stitch while working sleeve increase every 4th row a total of 7 [8] 10 [15] times as follows [RS]: K1, M1, knit to the last stitch, M1, k1.

There are now a total of 59 (65) 73 (89) sts on the needle. Work straight until sleeve measures 15 [17] 19 [21] cm.

Now bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows. There are now 47 [53] 61 [77] sts left on the needle.

Then bind off 2 sts at the beginning of the following 10 (12) 14 (16) rows. There are now 27 (29) 33 (45) sts left on the needle.

Now bind off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 [3] 4 [4] rows. Then bind off the remaining 21 [20] 21 [33] sts.

# FINISHING:

Sew the sleeve seams and sew the sleeves in the armholes.

Weave in the ends and gently steam the finished work into shape.

Sew in the buttons.



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
