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ABBREVIATIONS:

st(s)	= stitch(es)	rep	= repeat
k	= knit	yo	= yarn over

The sweater is worked from bottom to top on circular needles, the sleeves are worked on double pointed needles.

FRONT AND BACK:

Cast on 180 [198] 210 [216] 234 sts on the size 12 [2½ mm] 60 cm circular needles. Place a mrk at the beg of the round and after 90 [99] 105 [108] 117 sts. These mrks mark the sides. Work 4 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Change to the size 11 [3 mm] 60 cm circular needles. **Round 1:** *P1, k1* rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 2: Rep round 1.

Round 3: *K1, p1* rep from * to * the entire round.

Round 4: Rep round 3.

Round 5: *p2tog* the entire round.

Round 6: *K1, p1 in the same st* the entire round.

Round 1-6 creates the patt. Cont in patt until the work measures approx. 15½ (17) 18½ (20) 21½ cm, end with a round 4 of the patt so the next round is a round 5.

Now dec as follows:

Sizes 68 & 74: *[p2tog] 3 times, p3tog* rep from * to * the entire round. You now have 80 (88) sts left.

Size 86: *[p2tog] 2 times, p3tog* rep from * to * the entire round. You now have 90 sts left. Size 92: *[p2tog] 3 times, p3* rep from * to * the entire round. You now have 96 sts left. Size 104: *[p2tog] 3 times, p3tog* rep from * to* the entire round. You now have 104 sts left. Work the round 6 of the patt as you have so far. You now have 160 (176) 180 (192) 208 sts left. Work round 1-3 of the patt. On the 4th round cast off 4 sts on each side for sleeve, i.e. 2 sts on each side of the mrks. You now have 76 (84) 86 (92) 100 sts on the front and back. Let the work rest.

SLEEVE:

Cast on 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 sts on the size 12 (2½ mm) double pointed needles. Place a mrk at the beg of the round - this marks the inside of the sleeve. Work 4 rounds of rib, k1, p1. Change to the size 11 (3 mm) double pointed needles.

Work in patt as on the body while at the same time inc 1 st on each side of the mrk on every 6th round until you have a total of 60 (62) 64 (66) 68 sts. Cont in patt while at the same time inc 1 st on each side of the mrk on every 4th (4th) 4th (6th) 6th round until you have a total of 70 (72) 74 (78) 80 sts. Cont in patt until the work measures approx. 15,5 (17) 18,5 (20) 21,5 cm. Work

MEASUREMENTS

YARN

Delicate Fraya 100% Merino Wool extra fine 50 g = 175 m

YARDAGE 150 (150) 200 (200) 250 g

GAUGE

In patt on size 3 mm needles: 32 sts x 42 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 12 and 11 (2½ and 3 mm) 40 and 60 cm circular needles UK size 12 and 11 (2½ and 3 mm) double pointed needles, small crochet hook

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS small button, markers

Non Commercial - You may not use this material for commercial purposes. Copyright © 2021 FRAYAYARN.COM round 1-3 of the patt. On the round 4 cast off 2 sts on each side of the marker for the armhole. You now have 66 (68) 70 (74) 76 sts left. Let the work rest. Knit another sleeve in the same way.

YOKE:

Place all parts on the same size 11 (3 mm) 60 cm circular needles and place a mrk between the back and the left sleeve. This means that you will start with the left sleeve, then the front, then the right sleeve and then the back.

Cont in patt, i.e. round 5 of the patt and cont in patt until you are about to work row 5 of the patt again. Now dec as follows:

SIZES 68 & 74: 284 (304) STS (FRONT, BACK AND SLEEVES)

p2 (3), *[p2tog] 2 times, p3tog*, rep from * to * until the last 2 (0) sts before the marker, p2 (0). You now have 124 (132) sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 248 (264) sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

P3 (2), *p2tog, p3tog*, rep from * to * until the last 0 (2) sts before the mrk, p0 (2). You now have 101 (108) sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 202 (216) sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

P2 (1), *p2tog, p3tog*, rep from * to * on the entire round. Now 82 (87) sts rem.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 164 (174) sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

p2 (2), *p2tog, p3tog*, rep from * to * until the last 2 (2) sts before the mrk, p2 (2). You now have 68 (72) sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 136 (144) sts.

Now work back and forth to create an opening in the back.

Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows:

P2 (0), *p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 2 (0) sts before the mrk, p2 (0). You now have 48 (48) sts.

Work row 6 of the patt. You now have 96 (96) sts.

Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows:

P1 (1), *p2tog, p3tog*, rep from * to * the entire row. You now have 39 (39) sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 78 [78] sts.

Change to the size 12 (2½ mm) 40 cm circular needles. Work in rib, k1, p1, for the next 5 rows. Cast off all sts loosely.

SIZE 86: 312 STS (FRONT, BACK AND SLEEVES)

Cont in patt, i.e. round 5 of the patt and cont in patt until you are about to work row 5 of the patt again. Now dec as follows:

P2, *[p2tog] 2 times, p3tog* rep * from * until the last 2 sts before the mrk, p2. You now have 136 sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 272 sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

P1, *[p2tog] 3 times, p3tog*, rep from * to * until the last st before the mrk, p1. You now have 122 sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 244 sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

P3, *[p2tog] 2 times, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 3 sts before the mrk, p3. You now have 108 sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 216 sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

P1, *p2tog, p3tog* rep from * to* on the entire round, You now have 87 sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 174 sts.

Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows:

P2, *p2tog, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 2 sts before the mrk, p2. You now have 72 sts.

Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 144 sts.

Now work back and forth to create an opening in the back.

Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows:

P2, *p2tog, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 2 sts, p2. You now have 60 sts.

Work row 6 of the patt. You now have 120 sts.

Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows:

P2, *p3tog* rep from * to * until the last st, p1. You now have 42 sts.

Work row 6 of the patt. You now have 84 sts.

Change to the size 12 (2½ mm) 40 cm circular needles. Work in rib, k1, p1, for the next 5 rows. Cast off all sts loosely.



SIZES 92 & 104: 332 (352) STS FRONT, BACK AND SLEEVES)

Cont in patt, i.e. round 5 of the patt and cont in patt until you are about to work row 5 of the patt again. Now dec as follows: P2 [1], *[p2toq] 2 times, p3toq* rep from * to * until the last st before the mrk, p1 [1]. You now have 144 [152] sts. Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 288 [304] sts. Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows: PO (4), *[p2toq] 3 times, p3toq* rep from * to * until the last 0 (3) sts before the mrk, p0 (3). You now have 128 [139] sts. Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 256 [278] sts. Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows: P2 [4], *[p2tog] 3 times, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 2 [4] sts before the mrk, p2 [4]. You now have 116 (128) sts Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 232 (256) sts. Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows: P1 (2), *[p2 tog] 2 times, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 0 (2) sts before the mrk, p0 (2). You now have 100 [112] sts. Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 200 (224) sts. Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows: P2 [0], *[p2toq] 2 times, p3toq* rep from * to * until the last 2 [0] sts before the mrk, p2 [0]. You now have 88 [96] sts. Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 176 [192] sts. Cont in patt until the next round 5 of the patt. Dec as follows: P1 [2], *[p2tog] 2 times, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 0 [1] sts before the mrk, p0 [1]. You now have 76 (84) sts. Work round 6 of the patt. You now have 152 (168) sts. Now work back and forth to create an opening in the back. Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows: P1 [2], *p2tog, p3tog* rep from to until the last 1 [1] st, p1 [1]. You now have 62 [69] sts. Work row 6 of the patt. You now have 124 [138] sts. Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows: P2 [2], *[p3toq], p2toq* rep from * to * until the last 2 [1] sts, p2 [1]. You now have 52 [57] sts. Work row 6 of the patt. You now have 104 [114] sts. Cont in patt until the next row 5. Dec as follows: P2 [2], *p2tog, p3tog* rep from * to * until the last 2 [2] sts, p2 [2]. You now have 44 [48] sts. Work row 6 of the patt. You now have 88 [96] sts. Change to the size 12 (2½ mm), 40 cm circular needles. Work in rib, k1, p1, for the next 5 rows. Cast off all sts loosely.

POCKET:

Cast on 17 (17) 19 (19) 21 sts on the size 11 (3 mm) needles. Work in st st starting with a WS row until the work measures 4 (4) 4 (4,5) 5 cm. Work in rib, k1, p1, until the work measures 5 (5) 5 ($5\frac{1}{2}$) 6 cm and cast off all sts.

FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and block lightly. Crochet a small loop for the button at the neck opening. Sew on a small button on the other side. Sew the pocket on the side with invisible sts.
