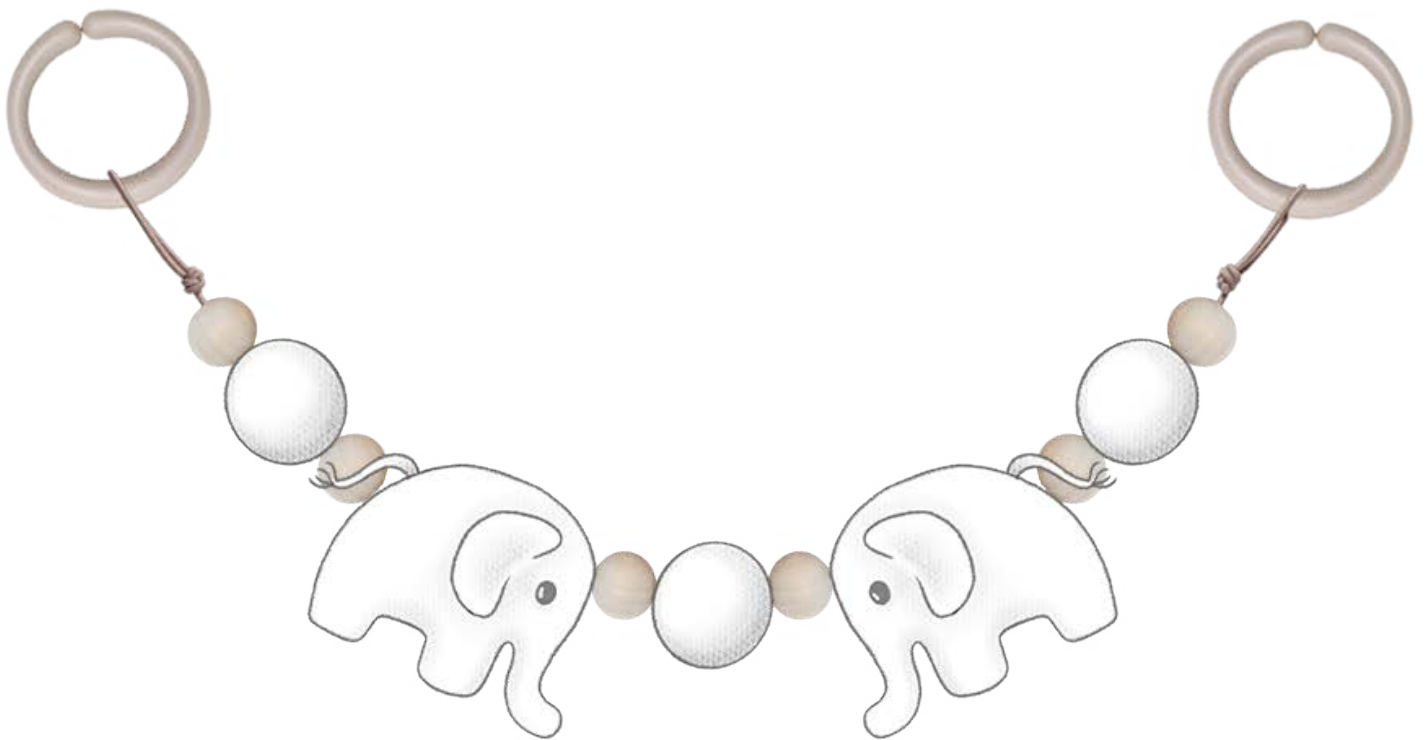


Pattern

Pram chain



YARN

Colourful FRAYA
100% cotton - 50 g = 170 m

YARN USAGE

Elephant pram chain L 40 cm **100 g**

Mounting of safety eyes**MATERIALS**

Eyes: 2 pairs 5 mm
Wooden beads: 6 pcs 20 mm
Elastic string 1 meter
Ring link: 2 pcs D60 cm
Filling
Crochet hook: 2,5 - 3,0 mm

Gauge: 24 m/10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS (UK TERMS)

st(s)	Stitch(es)
mr	Magic ring
sl st	Slip stitch
t-ch	Crochet 1 ch, turn work
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
2 dc tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
...	The instructions shown between these stars must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row - indicates the total number of stitches.

PRAM CHAIN

Elephants and balls are crocheted with 2 threads.

ELEPHANT (4 X)

1.)	15 sl st	(15)
2.)	2 m in the 2. st, 13 dc, 1 t-ch	(15)
3.)	14 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch	(16)
4.)	1 dc inc, 15 dc, 1 t-ch	(17)
5.)	16 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch	(18)
6.)	1 dc inc, 17 dc, 1 t-ch	(19)
7.)	18 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch	(20)
8. - 11.)	16 dc, 1 t-ch	(16)
12.)	16 dc, 5 sl st	(21)
13.)	Start in the 2. st on the sl st-chain, 20 dc, 1 t-ch	(20)
14. - 17.)	20 dc, 1 t-ch	(20)
18. - 19.)	14 dc, 1 t-ch	(14)
20.)	14 dc, 7 sl st	(21)
21.)	Start in the 2. st on the sl st-chain, 18 dc, 2 dc tog, 1 t-ch	(19)
22.)	2 dc tog, 17 dc, 1 t-ch	(18)
23.)	16 dc, 2 dc tog	(17)

Close off and use the rest of the yarn to sew the two parts together.

EARS (4 X)

1.)	mr with 5 dc, t-ch	(5)
2.)	*1 dc inc* x 5, t-ch	(10)
3.)	*1 dc, 1 dc udt* x 5, t-ch	(15)
4.)	*2 dc, 1 dc udt* x 5	(20)

Close off and use the rest of the yarn to sew the ears of the head with.

TAIL

Make a loop from a 40 cm piece of yarn. Pass the needle under a stitch on the back of the elephant, insert the needle into the loop and pull it through. Pull the yarn through the loop and then crochet 10 sl st. Break the yarn and pull the last stitch to form a knot.

Shape the head and eye socket:

Thread approximately 25 cm of yarn. The needle is inserted under the chin and up at the inside of the eye. A stitch is sewn over and the needle is brought out below the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure forms a depression above the eye. To keep the pressure on the indentation, sew through a few stitches below the chin. The socket on one eye is now finished.

BALLS (3 X)

1.)	mr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	*1 dc inc* x 6	(12)
3.)	*1 dc inc, 1 dc* x 6	(18)
4.)	*1 dc inc, 2 dc* x 6	(24)
5. - 6.)	24 dc	(24)
7.)	*2 dc tog, 2 dc* x 6	(18)
8.)	*2 dc tog, 1 dc* x 6	(12)
9.)	*2 dc tog* x 6	(6)
