Eyes 10 mm TPE ring: D75

Rattle cellophane: 10 x 10 cm Rattle box: D22 x 19 mm Squeaker: 2 pcs 25 x 14 mm

Filling

Crochet hook: 2,5 - 3,0 mm

Gauge: 30 fm/10 cm

Add a rattle box and filling to the head. Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten and sew the head together.

# Shape the head and the eye hollows:

Thread the yarn for about 25 cm. Insert the needle under the chin and up by the inner side of the eye. Stitch over one stitch and bring the needle out at the lower part of the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure creates a depression above the eye. To maintain the pressure on the depression, stitch through a couple of stitches at the lower part of the chin. The depression on one eye is now completed. Repeat the process on the opposite eye.

For the hair, make 10 cm long strips of the yarn and pull them through a st so that they are double. Tie a knot and use scissors to style the hair.

Sew on eyebrows using the black yarn.
