## BODY [START AT THE TAIL):

Start with co 1.
Work 3 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 6 db , place a marker thread
Round 2-4: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=6 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 2 db in every 3rd db $=8 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6-7: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=8 \mathrm{db}$
Change to co 2 .
Round 8: 2 db in every 4th $\mathrm{db}=10 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9-12: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=8 \mathrm{db}$
Change to co 3 , from here change color every 4th round the rest of the body in the following order: co 4, 1, 2, 3 .
Round 13: 2 db in every 2nd $\mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$
Round 14: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 15: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 16: 2 db in every 2nd $\mathrm{db}=45 \mathrm{db}$
Round 17-20: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=45 \mathrm{db}$
Round 21: 2 db in every 3rd db $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Round 22-24: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$
Round 25: 2 db in every 4th $\mathrm{db}=75 \mathrm{db}$
Round 26-28: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=75 \mathrm{db}$
Round 29: 2 db in every 5th $\mathrm{db}=90 \mathrm{db}$
Round 30-33: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=90 \mathrm{db}$
Round 34: 2 db in every 6th $\mathrm{db}=105 \mathrm{db}$

Round 52-53: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=84 \mathrm{db}$
Round 54: Crochet 2 db tog for every 5th and 6th $\mathrm{db}=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 55-56: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 57: Crochet 2 db tog for every 4th and 5th $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$
Round 58-59: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$
Round 60: Crochet 2 db tog for every 3rd and 4th $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$
Round 61: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$
Round 62: Crochet 2 db tog for every 6th and 7th $\mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$
Round 63: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$
Round 64: Crochet 2 db tog for every 5th and 6th $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 65: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$, end with one sls in the next db , cut the yarn.

## HEAD AND TRUNK:

Start with co 1 and then change co every 4th round in the following order: $\operatorname{co} 2,3,4,1$.
Work 30 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 2: 2 db in every 6th $\mathrm{db}=35 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=35 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: 2 db in every 5th $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$

## YARN

Colourful Fraya
100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=170 \mathrm{~m}$
YARDAGE
Co 1: 1 ball
Co 2: 1 ball [lightest stripe color]
Co 3: 1 ball
Co 4: 1 ball
Black scrap yarn for the eyes and mouth

CROCHET GAUGE
$24 \mathrm{db}=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 14 (2 mm) crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

## NOTIONS

Fibre filling 250 g

Round 5: 2 db in every 6th $\mathrm{db}=49 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=49 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: 2 db in every 7th $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8: 2 db in every 8th $\mathrm{db}=63 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=63 \mathrm{db}$
Round 10: 2 db in every 9th $\mathrm{db}=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 11-16: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 17: Crochet 2 db tog for every 9th and 10th $\mathrm{db}=63 \mathrm{db}$
Round 18: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=63 \mathrm{db}$
Round 19: Crochet 2 db tog for every 8th and 9th $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$
Round 20: Crochet 2 db tog for every 7th and 8th $\mathrm{db}=49 \mathrm{db}$ Change to the lightest stripe co the next 10 rounds.
Round 21: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=49 \mathrm{db}$
Round 22: Crochet 2 db tog for every 6th and 7th $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$
Round 23: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$
Round 24: Crochet 2 db tog for every 5th and 6th $\mathrm{db}=35 \mathrm{db}$
Round 25: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=35 \mathrm{db}$
Round 26: Crochet 2 db tog for every 6th and 7th $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 27-30: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Continue with co 3 and then change co every 3 rounds in the following order: co $4,1,2,3$.
Round 31: Crochet 2 db tog for every 9th and 10th $\mathrm{db}=27 \mathrm{db}$
Round 32-33: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=27 \mathrm{db}$
Round 34: Crochet 2 db tog for every 8th and 9th $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 35-36: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 37: Crochet 2 db tog for every 7th and 8th $\mathrm{db}=21 \mathrm{db}$
Round 38-39: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=21 \mathrm{db}$
Round 40: Crochet 2 db tog for every 6th and 7th $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 41-42: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 43: Crochet 2 db tog for every 5th and 6th $\mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$
Round 44-66: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$ [a total of 12 stripes on the trunk]
Change to co 3 .
Round 67: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$
Round 68: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$, end with 1 sls in the next db , cut the yarn.

## END OF THE TRUNK:

Crochet with co 3
Work 3 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 8 db .
Round 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 2 db in every $2 \mathrm{nd} \mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 2 db in every 4th $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Crochet the end tog with the trunk with a round of db , end with 1 sls in the first st.

## LEGS:

Start with co 1 and then change co every 3rd round in the following order: $\operatorname{co} 2,3,4,1$.
Work 3 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 8 db .
Round 2: 2 db in every 2nd $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: 2 db in every $3 \mathrm{rd} \mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 2 db in every 4th $\mathrm{db}=20 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=20 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: 2 db in every 10th $\mathrm{db}=22 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8-15: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=20 \mathrm{db}$ [20 stripes in all], end with 1 sls in the next db .

## EARS:

Start with the lightest co.
Turn all rows by working 1 cs.
Work 9 cs, turn.
Row 1: 9 db , turn.
Row 2: crochet 2 db tog, 1 db in each of the next 5 db , crochet 2 db tog.
Row 3: Cont along the side over the 2 rows with 3 db , the bottom with 7 db and the other side with 3 db, turn $=13 \mathrm{db}$
Row 4 : $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db, 2 db , turn = 17 db
Cont in stripes as on the trunk but change co every 2nd round.
Row 5: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}$, turn $=21 \mathrm{db}$


Row 6: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 7 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db, 4 db , turn $=25 \mathrm{db}$
Row 7: $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 9 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db, 5 db , turn $=29 \mathrm{db}$
Row 8: $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 11 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db, 6 db , turn $=33 \mathrm{db}$
Row 9: $7 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 13 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 7 \mathrm{db}$, turn $=37 \mathrm{db}$
Row 10: $8 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 15 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 8 \mathrm{db}$, turn $=41 \mathrm{db}$
Row 11: $9 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 17 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db, 9 db , turn $=45 \mathrm{db}$
Row 12: $10 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 19 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 10 \mathrm{db}$, turn $=49 \mathrm{db}$
Row 13: $11 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 21 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 11 \mathrm{db}$, turn $=53 \mathrm{db}$
Row 14: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=53 \mathrm{db}$, pull the yarn through.

## EYES:

Worked in black.
Work 4 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Round 1: 8 db
Round 2: 2 db in every 2nd db , end with 1 sls in the next db .

## FINISHING:

Weave in ends, fill the parts well with fiber filling.
Sew the head and the body tog.
Sew the legs on, place the hind legs about 3 cm from the marker thread over the 4th and 5th stripe from the tail, the front legs about $2,5 \mathrm{~cm}$ from the marker thread in the middle of the 10th stripe from the tail.
Sew on the ears - pull on the thread to "ruffle" the ears, Place the ears between the 3rd and 4th stripe from the neck - with $4,5 \mathrm{~cm}$ between the ears.
Sew on the eyes on the middle of the wide light coloured stripe. Embroider eyebrows and mouth with black yarn.
