Round 27: 1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog, $[1 \text{ db in the next 7 db, crochet 2 db tog}] <math>\times 5$, 1 db in the next 6 db = 50 db

Round 6: *1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the entire round = 36 db

Round 4: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the entire round = 24 db

Round 5-14: 1 db in every db = 24 db

Round 15: *1 db in the first 6 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the entire round = 21 db

Round 16-18: 1 db in every db = 21 db

Round 19: *1 db in the first 5 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the entire round = 18 db

Round 20-22: 1 db in every db = 18 db

Round 23: *1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the entire round = 15 db

Round 7: 1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 4 db = 14 db

Round 8: 1 db in every db = 14 db

Round 9: 1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 5 db = 16 db

Round 10: 1 db in every db = 16 db

Round 11: 1 db in the first 6 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 8 db = 18 db

Make 2 of each co, a total of 6 spikes.

With co 2, co 3 or co 4 work 3 cs, connect to make a ring with 1 sls.

Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next 2 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next db* rep from * to * the entire round = 16 db

Round 4-8: 1 db in every db = 16 db

Cut the yarn.



FINISHING:

Fill the body with fiber filling and sew on the head on the body. Sew on the stomach. Fill arms and legs with fiber filling and sew them on the body. Put a bit of filling in the spikes and sew them along the back from the head to the tail.

FVFS-

With black yarn 3 cs, connect to make a ring with 1 sls.

Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring.

Round 2: Change to white yarn and work 2 db in each db = 12 db BUT in the last 2 db insert the hook into the middle of the eye - this will make the sts long an create the "gleam" in the eye. Cut the yarn and make another identical eye.

Sew the eyes on the head.

With co 2 embroider nostrils.
