Worked from the bottom up in co 1 in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread where the round starts and let it follow up through the work. Crochet 4 cs, join to make a ring with 1 sls. Round 1: 6 db in the ring. STOMACH:

Worked in co 2. Turn all rows by working 1 cs. Please note that the stomach is not symmetrical but a little crooked. Work 29 cs, turn Row 1: 27 db, beg in the 2nd cs from the hook, you now have 1 cs left, work 4 db in this cs and cont working 27 db on the other side of the cs row. Row 2: 58 db (WS) Row 3: 27 db, 2 db in each of the next 4 db, 1 sls Row 4: Skip the sls, 41 db, 1 sls Row 5: Skip the sls, 18 db, 2 db in each of the next 4 db, 14 db, 1 sls. Row 6: Skip the sls, 36 db, 1 sls

Crochet 4 cs with co 3, join to make a ring with 1 sls. Round 1: 6 db in the ring. Round 2: 2 db in every db = 12 db Round 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 18 db Round 4: *2 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 24 db Round 5: *3 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 30 db **Round 6-9:** 1 db in every db = 30 db [4 rounds] Round 10: *3 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 24 db **Round 11:** 1 db in every db = 24 db Round 12: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 18 db **Round 13-14:** 1 db in every db = 18 db Change to co 1 and work even until the arm measures approx. 14 cm, cut the yarn. LEG: Worked from the bottom up in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread where the round starts and let it follow up through the work. Crochet 9 cs with co 3 Round 1: Turn, 7 db starting from the 2nd cs from the hook, you now have 1 cs left, work 4 db in this dc, work 7 db on the other side of the cs row, work another 2 db in the first/last cs = 20 db. Place a marker thread here, this is the beg on the round. Round 2: *7 db, 2 db in each of the next 3 db* rep from * to* the rest of the round = 26 db Round 3: *8 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db * rep from * to* the rest of the round = 32 db

Round 4: 8 db, 2 db in the next db, 6 db, 2 db in the next db, 8 db, 2 db in the next db, 6 db, 2 db in the next db = 36 db

Round 11: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times, 16 db = 34 db Round 12: *1 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times, 16 db = 28 db Round 13: 1 db in every db = 28 db Round 14: *crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times, 16 db = 22 db **Round 15-16:** 1 db in every db = 22 db (2 rounds) Round 17: 22 db, place a marker thread since the round starts here now. Change to co 1 and work even until the leg measures 16 cm. BACK OF THE HEAD AND TOP OF THE SNOUT: Start at the middle of the back of the head and work around in spiral rounds, then cont working in rows to create the top of the snout. Work 9 cs with co 1. Fold the head in the middle and place 2 marker threads 5 cm from the middle of the bottom of the head. These are used when sewing the pieces tog.



CHEEKS:

The cheeks are worked in co 2. First work 2 circles and then crochet these tog and then work the the bottom of the snout. The circles are worked in spiral rounds. Crochet 4 cs with co 3, join to make a ring with 1 sls. Round 1: 6 db in the ring. Round 2: 2 db in every db = 12 db Round 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 18 db Round 4: *2 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 24 db Round 5: *3 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 30 db Cont in this way by working 6 inc on every round until you have 78 db on the round. Cut the yarn and let the work rest. Crochet another circle in the same way without cutting the yarn. Now crochet tog the 2 circles and cont working in rows. Turn all rows by working 1 cs. Work 4 cs, cont working 8 db on 1 circle, 1 sls Row 1: Skip the sls, 7 db, 5 db around the cs, 8 db (on circle), 1 sls. Row 2: Skip the sls, 7 db, crochet 2 db toq, 3 db, crochet 2 db toq, 4 db, 1 sls. Row 3: Skip the sls, 14 db, 1 sls. Row 4: Skip the sls, 5 db, crochet 2 db tog, 2 db, crochet 2 db tog, 16 db. Row 5: Skip the first db, 35 db Row 6: 1 db, crochet 2 db toq, 13 db, crochet 2 db toq, 13 db, 2 db toq, 1 db. Row 7: Skip the first db, 30 db Row 8: Skip the first db, 1 db, crochet 2 db tog, 10 db, crochet 3 db tog, 10 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db Row 9: 25 db Row 10: 1 db, crochet 2 db tog, 19 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db Row 11: 23 db Row 12: 1 db, crochet 2 db tog, 17 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db Row 13-15: 21 db [3 rows] Row 16: 1 db, crochet 2 db toq, 15 db, crochet 2 db toq, 1 db Row 17-19: 21 db (3 rows) Row 20: 1 db, crochet 2 db toq, 13 db, crochet 2 db toq, 1 db Row 21-23: 17 db [3 rows] Row 24: 1 db, crochet 2 db tog, 11 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db Row 25-27: 15 db [3 rows] Cut the yarn. Place a marker thread from the middle from the 4 cs between the circles and 4 cm out on the circles, approx. 10 cm in between the 2 threads. These are used when sewing the pieces tog. SNOUT: Worked in co 3 in spiral rounds. Crochet 4 cs with co 3, join to make a ring with 1 sls. Round 1: 6 db in the ring. Round 2: 2 db in every db = 12 db Round 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 18 db Round 4: 3 db, 1 db and tr in the next db, 3 tr in the next db, 1 tr and 1 db in the next db, 4 db, 1 db and 1 tr in the next db, 3 tr in the next db, 1 tr and 1 db in the next db, 6 db. Cut the yarn.

EARS:

Crochet 2 ears in co 1 and 2 ears in co 2. Turn all rows with 1 cs. Work 14 cs. Row 1: 13 db starting in the 2nd cs from the hook Row 2-6: 13 db Row 7: 1 db, crochet 2 db toq, 7 db, crochet 2 db toq, 1 db Row 8-10: 11 db Row 11: 1 db, crochet 2 db tog, 5 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db Row 12-14: 9 db Row 15: 1 db, crochet 2 db tog, 3 db, crochet 2 db tog, 1 db Row 16-18: 7 db Row 19: 1 db, 2 db tog, 1 db, 2 db tog, 1 db Row 20: 2 db, 2 db toq, 1 db Row 21: 1 db, 2 db tog, 1 db Cut the yarn. Crochet 1 ear of co 1 and 1 ear of co 2 toq with db in co 1, the inner ear (co 2) should face you.



EYES:

Work in co 3. Work 4 cs, join to make a ring with 1 sls. **Round 1:** 6 db in the ring. **Round 2:** 2 db in every db = 12 db Cut the yarn. Crochet another eye in the same way. Embroider a couple of sts with co 2 to create the pupil.

FINISHING:

Sew the back of the head and cheeks tog with small sts from the RS. Start at the snout and sew until the marker threads, hold the cheek a little to shape it. Sew the snout on with small sts from the RS. Fill the body with fiber filling. Sew the stomach on the body. Fill the head with fiber filling, make sure to fill the cheeks well. Sew the head on the body, the middle of the stomach should be places at the middle of the snout. Sew the ears on the head, co 2 should be turned towards the snout, shape the ear by folding it and ruffle it a bit at the bottom. Sew the eyes on the head. Fill the arms with fiber filling, sew them on the body.

Fill the legs with fiber filling, sew them on the body.
