Stripe patt: crochet in colour order $2,3,4,5$ and $6-3$ rounds of each colour.

## BODY:

The entire body is worked in stripe patt as described above.
Place a mrk at the beg of the round - it can otherwise be difficult to tell where the round starts. It is a good idea to weave in the ends as you go since it can be difficult to weave in the ends when the body is complete. You can tie the ends together in knots and let them hang inside the body. With co 2 crochet 4 cs and join to make a circle with 1 sls
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring
Round 2: Work 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: *1 db in the first $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: *1 db in the first $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=40 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: *1 db in the first $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=50 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=50 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9: *1 db in the first $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Round 10: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$
Round 11: *1 db in the first $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db} *$ rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 12: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 13: *1 db in the first $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db} *$ rep from * to $*$ a total of 10 times $=80 \mathrm{db}$
Round 14: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=80 \mathrm{db}$
Round 15: *1 db in the first $7 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db * rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=90 \mathrm{db}$
Round 16-27: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=90 \mathrm{db}$ (12 rounds)
Round 28: *1 db in the first 7 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=80 \mathrm{db}$
Round 29-31: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=80 \mathrm{db}$ [ 3 rounds]
Round 32: * 1 db in the first 6 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=70 \mathrm{db}$
Round 33-35: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=70 \mathrm{db}$ [3 rounds]
Round 36: *1 db in the first 5 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Round 37-39: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$ [3 rounds]
Round 40: *1 db in the first 4 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=50 \mathrm{db}$
Round 41-43: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=50 \mathrm{db}$ [ 3 rounds]
Round 44: *1 db in the first 3 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 10 times $=40 \mathrm{db}$
Round 45-49: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=40 \mathrm{db}$ [5 rounds]
Round 50: * 1 db in the first 6 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 5 times $=35 \mathrm{db}$ Work even until the body has 22 stripes. Leave a long end of the yarn to use for sewing on the head.

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Size UK size 12/13 [ $2,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ ] crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

## NOTIONS

approx. 85 g of fiber filling

## HEAD:

With co 1 crochet 4 cs and join to make a circle with 1 sls
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring
Round 2: Work 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: Work 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=32 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=32 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: *1 db in the first $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=40 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: *1 db in the first $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9: *1 db in the first $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=56 \mathrm{db}$ Round 10-21: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$ (12 rounds)
Change to co 2 and cont in stripe patt, remember to weave in ends as you go.
Round 22-23: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$ [2 rounds]
Round 24: *1 db in the first $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=64 \mathrm{db}$
Round 25-32: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=64 \mathrm{db}$ [8 rounds]
Round 33: *1 db in the first 6 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=56 \mathrm{db}$
Round 34: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=56 \mathrm{db}$
Round 35: *1 db in the first 5 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Round 36: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$
Round 37: *1 db in the first 4 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=40 \mathrm{db}$
Round 38: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=40 \mathrm{db}$
Round 39: *1 db in the first 3 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=32 \mathrm{db}$
Round 40: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=32 \mathrm{db}$
Round 41: *1 db in the first 2 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 42: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 43: *1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 8 times $=16 \mathrm{db}$
Round 44: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Fill with fiber filling
Round 45: Crochet 2 db tog the entire round $=8$ sts
Cut the yarn and sew the hole.

## ARM:

With co 1 crochet 4 cs and join to make a circle with 1 sls
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring
Round 2: Work 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: *1 db in the first $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: *1 db in the first $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7-10: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$ [ 4 rounds)
Round 11: *1 db in the first 3 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 12: *1 db in the first 2 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 13: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Change to co 2 and cont in stripe patt until you have 10 stripes and the arm measures approx. 12 cm. Remember to weave in ends as you go.

Make another identical arm.

## LEG:

With co 1 crochet 4 cs and join to make a circle with 1 sls
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring
Round 2: Work 2 db in every db = 12 db
Round 3: *1 db in the first $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 5: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: *1 db in the first $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db} *$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8: *1 db in the first $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9-12: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$ [4 rounds]
Round 13: *1 db in the first 4 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 14: *1 db in the first 3 db , crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 15: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Change to co 2 and cont in stripe patt until you have 10 stripes and the leg measures approx. 12,5 cm . Remember to weave in ends as you go.
Make another identical leg.


## EARS:

With co 1 crochet 4 cs and join to make a circle with 1 sls
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring
Round 2: Work 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3-4: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$ [2 rounds]
Round 5: *1 db in the first $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 6: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 7: *1 db in the first $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db * rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Round 9: *1 db in the first $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Round 10-18: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$ [ 9 rounds).
Cut the yarn but leave a long end of the yarn to use for sewing on the ear.
Make another identical ear.

## HORN:

With co 2 crochet 4 cs and join to make a circle with 1 sls
Round 1: Work 6 db in the ring
Round 2: Work 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 3: *1 db in the first $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Round 4-6: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$ [3 rounds]
Round 7: *1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Round 8-17: Work even for 10 rounds
Cut the yarn but leave a long end of the yarn to use for sewing on the horn.
Make another identical horn.

## TAIL:

Crochet 16 cs . Work 15 db starting from the 2 cs from the hook.
Cut the yarn but leave a long end of the yarn to use for sewing on the tail.

## FINISHING:

Fill the body with fiber filling and sew the head on the body.
Fill the arms with fiber filling and sew them on the body.
Fold the ears in the middle so they are double, fold them again along the middle and sew them on the head.
Fill some fiber filling in the horns but not the stem. Sew them on the head between the ears.
Embroider ears and a mouth on the giraffe.
Sew the tail on the back of the giraffe.
