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# **ABBREVIATIONS:**

st(s) = stitch(es)
db = double crochet
sls = slip stitch
cs = chain stitch
beg = beginning
rep = repeat
tog = together

The rabbit is crocheted in spiral rounds in one piece. This means that there is almost no finishing required. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.

#### ARM:

Work 2 cs.

Round 1: 5 db in the first cs.

**Round 2:** 2 db in each db = 10 db.

Round 3: \*1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 15 db.

Round 4-6: 1 db in each db = 15 db.

Round 7: \*1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db toq\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 12 db.

Round 8: 1 db in each db = 12 db.

**Round 9:** \*1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 10 db. **Round 10-19:** 1 db in each db = 10 db, end with 1 sls, cut the yarn and pull it through the st.

Crochet another arm in the same way.

# LEG:

Work 2 cs.

Round 1: 6 db in the first cs.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db

Round 3: \*1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 16 db.

**Round 4-7:** 1 db in each db = 16 db

**Round 8:** \*1 db in the first 6 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 14 db.

Round 9: 1 db in each db = 14 db

**Round 10:** \*1 db in the first 5 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 12 db. **Round 11-30:** 1 db in each db = 12 db, end with 1 sls, cut the yarn and pull it through the st.

Round 11-30: 1 up in each up = 12 up, enu with 1 sis, cut the yarn and pun it through the s

Crochet another leg in the same way but without cutting the yarn.

#### BODY:

Now crochet tog the legs and crochet the body.

**Round 1:** Crochet 9 db on the last leg you made, crochet 9 db on the first leg you made, you now have 18 sts on the round.

**Round 2:** \*1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 24 db.

**Round 3:** \*1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 30 db.

**Round 4:** \*1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 36 db. Sew the little hole between the legs and fill the legs with fiber filling, the rest of the rabbit is filled as you go.

**Round 5-11:** 1 db in each db = 36 db.

**Round 12:** \*1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 30 db. Find the side of the rabbit and mark between the sts - be careful to do this right or else the rabbit will turn out crocked.

Work db until 1 st before the side, crochet 8 db on one arm, skip 2 sts on the body, crochet 13 db on the body (until 1 st before the other side), crochet 8 db on the other arm, skip 2 sts on the body, crochet 6 db on the body (mid back), the round now starts here and you have a total of 42 db on the round.

**Round 13:** 1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog, \*1 db in the next 5 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round, end with 2 db = 36 db.

**Round 14:** 1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog, \*1 db in the next 7 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round, end with 3 db = 32 db.

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Sew the little holes under the arms.

approx. 22 cm

#### YARN

Colourful Fraya 100% Cotton 50 g = 170 m

# YARDAGE

approx. 30 g + leftover yarn for the

#### **CROCHET GAUGE**

24 db x 28 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm

#### SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 12/13 (2½ mm) crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

### NOTIONS

Approx. 15 g of fibre filling,

Non Commercial - You may not use this material for commercial purposes. Copyright © 2021 FRAYAYARN.COM **Round 15:** 1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog, \*1 db in the next 6 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round, end with 3 db = 28 db.

**Round 16:** 1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog, \*1 db in the next 5 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round, end with 3 db = 24 db.

**Round 17:** 1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog, \*1 db in the next 4 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round, end with 3 db = 20 db.

Round 18: \*1 db in the next 3 db, crochet 2 db toq\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 16 db.

Round 19: 1 db in each db = 16 db.

Remember to fill the rabbit with fiber filling as you go.

Now crochet the head.

Round 20: \*1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 24 db.

Round 21: \*1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 32 db.

Round 22: 1 db in each db = 32 db.

Round 23: \*1 db in the first 7 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 36 db.

Round 24: \*1 db in the first 8 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 40 db.

**Round 25-29:** 1 db in each db = 40 db.

Round 30: \*1 db in the next 6 db, crochet 2 db toq\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 35 db.

Round 31: \*1 db in the next 5 db, crochet 2 db toq\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 30 db.

Round 32: \*1 db in the next 4 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 25 db.

**Round 33:** \*1 db in the next 3 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 20 db.

It is a good idea to embroider eyes and a mouth on the rabbit now. Be careful to place the face at the center, the lowest st of the snout is embroider on round 25 (the 6th round of the head). See fig 1.

**Round 34:** \*1 db in the next 2 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 15 db.

Round 35: \*1 db in the next db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 10 db.

Round 36: \*crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 5 db, cut the yarn.

Put more fiber filling in the rabbit if needed.

Weave in the end by sewing through the last 5 sts, pull tight and weave in the end well.

# EAR:

Work 2 cs.

Round 1: 4 db in the first cs.

**Round 2:** \*1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 6 db.

Round 3: 1 db in each db = 6 db.

Round 4: \*1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 8 db.

Round 5: \*1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 10 db.

**Round 6:** \*1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 12 db.

Round 7: \*1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 14 db.

**Round 8-17:** 1 db in each db = 14 db.

Round 18: \*1 db in the next 5 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 12 db.


**Round 19:** db in each db = 12 db.

Round 20: \*1 db in the next 4 db, crochet 2 db tog\* rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 10 db.

**Round 21:** \*1 db in the next 3 db, crochet 2 db  $tog^*$  rep from \* to \* rest of the round = 8 db, cut the yarn.

# FINISHING:

Sew the ears on the rabbit, the distance between the ears should be approx. 3 cm.



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
