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ABBREVIATIONS:

rd	= Rd
st(s)	= stitch(es)
db	= double crochet

DECREASE: to make a neat, invisible decrease [crochet 2 db tog] do as follows: Insert the hook into the first loop of the st closest to you on both sts, yo, pull the yarn through the two loops, yo, and pull the yarn through the two loops = 1 st decreased.

COLOR CHANGE: Insert the needle into the next db and pull up a loop = 2 loops on the hook. Now pull the new co through both loops and you are now ready to work with the new co.

BODY:

Work 3 cs with co 1, join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1: 6 db in the ring [crochet aRd the yarn end, at the end tighten to close the hole]

Rd 2: 2 db in every db = 12 db

Rd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db

Rd 4: *2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 24 db

Rd 5: *3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 30 db

Rd 6: *4 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 36 db

Rd 7: *5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 42 db

Rd 8: *6 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 48 db

Rd 9: 1 db in every db = 48 db

Rd 10: *5 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 56 db

Rd 11-17: 1 db in every db = 56 db

Rd 18: *12 db, crochet 2 db tog [se TIP above] * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 52 db

Rd 19-20: 1 db in every db = 52 db

Rd 21: 5 db, crochet 2 db tog, *11 db, crochet 2 db tog *, rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 48 db

Rd 22-24: 1 db in every db = 48 db

Sew a small bag and fill with plastic granules. Place the bag in the bottom of the work and keep working.

Rd 25: *6 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 42 db

Rd 26: 1 db in every db = 42 db

Rd 27: *5 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 36 db

Rd 28-29: 1 db in every db = 36 db

Rd 30: *4 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 30 db

Rd 31: *3 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 24 db

Rd 32: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db

Rd 33: 1 db in every db = 18 db

Cut the yarn. Leave the yarn end long enough to use for sewing together.

MEASUREMENTS

approx. 17 cm

YARN

Colourful Fraya

100% Cotton

50 g = 170 m

+

Shiny Fraya

66% Viscose + 34% Polyester

25 g = 125 m

YARDAGE

Colourful:

Co. 1: 50 g, Co. 2: 50 g, Co. 3: 50 g

Shiny: 25 g

CROCHET GAUGE

The pig will look the best if you crochet a bit tightly.

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK Size 11 [3 mm] crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

NOTIONS

Leftover black yarn for the eyes and nostrils, plastic granules, leftover cotton fabric and approx. 50 g fiber filling

HEAD:

Work 3 cs with co 2, join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1: 6 db in the ring [crochet aRd the yarn end, at the end tighten to close the hole]

Rd 2: 2 db in every db = 12 db

Change to co 1.

Rd 3: 1 db in every db, but only in the back loop = 12 db

Rd 4: 1 db in every db = 12 db

Rd 5: 1 db in every db = 12 db

Rd 6: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db

Rd 7: *2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 24 db

Rd 8: *3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 30 db

Rd 9: *4 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 36 db

Rd 10-20: 1 db in every db = 36 db

Rd 21: *4 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 30 db

Rd 22: *3 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 24 db

Rd 23: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db, fill the head with fiber filling

Rd 24: *1 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 12 db

Rd 25: Crochet 2 tog the entire Rd = 6 db

Cut the yarn and use the end to sew the hole all the way closed.

ARM:

Work 3 cs with co 2, join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1: 5 db in the ring [crochet aRd the yarn end, at the end tighten to close the hole]

Rd 2: 2 db in every db = 10 db

Rd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 15 db

Rd 4: 1 db in every db = 15 db

Change to co 1.

Rd 5-10: 1 db in every db = 15 db.

Cut the yarn and use the end to sew the arm on the body.

Crochet another arm in the same way.

LEG:

Work 3 cs with co 2, join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1: 5 db in the ring [crochet aRd the yarn end, at the end tighten to close the hole]

Rd 2: 2 db in every db = 10 db

Rd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 15 db

Rd 4: 1 db in every db = 15 db

Change to co 1.

Rd 5-15: 1 db in every db = 15 db.

Cut the yarn and use the end to sew the leg on the body.

Crochet another leg in the same way.

TAIL:

Work 7 cs with co 1. Work 3 db in the 2nd cs from the hook. Work 3 db in all cs

EARS:

Work 3 cs with co 1, join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1: 4 db in the ring [crochet aRd the yarn end, at the end tighten to close the hole]

Rd 2: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 6 db

Rd 3: 1 db in every db = 6 db

Rd 4: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 9 db

Rd 5: *2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 12 db

Rd 6: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db

Rd 7: *2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 24 db

Rd 8-9: 1 db in every db = 24 db

Rd 10: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db

Rd 11: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 12 db

Cut the yarn. Crochet another ear in the same way.

STOMACH:

Start with co 4. Work 4 cs and join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1: 6 db in the ring [crochet aRd the yarn end, at the end tighten to close the hole]

Rd 2: 2 db in every db = 12 db. Place a mrk at the beg of the Rd

Rd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 18 db

Rd 4: *2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 24 db

Rd 5: 2 db, move the mrk to here, this is now the beg of the Rd, *3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 30 db

Rd 6: *4 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * the rest of the Rd = 36 db

Work 1 sls, cut the yarn



CROWN:

Work 16 cs with co 3, join to make a ring with 1 sls.

Rd 1-3: 1 db in every db = 16 db

Rd 4: *Skip the next db, in the next db work 3 tr [in the same db], skip 1, work 1 sls* rep from * to * the entire Rd.

Rd 5: *1 db in the 1st tr from the previous Rd [1 db, 3 cs, 1 db] in the 2nd tr from the previous Rd, 1 db in the 3rd tr from the previous Rd, 1 sls* rep from * to * the entire Rd. Cut the yarn.

FINISHING:

Fill the body with fiber filling. Sew the head on the body, sew some sts from the head down to the pigs chest as if the pig is looking down. Fold the ears in the middle and sew them on the head. Fill a bit of fiber filling in the arms and legs and sew them on the body. Sew on the tail. Embroider eyes and nostrils with black. Sew the stomach on with invisible sts. Sew the crown on the head between the ears.
