Worked from the bottom up in co 1 in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.
Work 4 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: *2 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 5: *3 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 7: *5 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=42 \mathrm{db}$

Worked from the bottom up in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.
Work 4 cs with co 2 and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: * $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: *2 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 5-9: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$ [5 rounds)
Rnd 10: *1 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=16 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 11: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Change to co 1 and work even until the arm measures 14 cm , cut the yarn.

Fibre filling approx. 200 g

## LEGS:

Worked from the bottom up in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.
Work 6 cs with co 2 .
Rnd 1: Turn, work 4 db starting in the 2nd cs from the hook, you now have 1 st left, work 4 db in this cs and cont working 4 db on the other side of the cs row, work another 2 db in the last/first cs = 14 db , place a marker thread, this is the start of the round.
Rnd 2: *1 db in each of the first $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in each of the next 3 db * rep from * to * the rest of the round $=20 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db in each of the first $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db * rep from * to * the rest of the round $=26 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 1 db in the first $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$

Rnd 9: *3 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 4 times, $14 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 4 times, $14 \mathrm{db}=26 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 11: *1 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 4 times, $14 \mathrm{db}=22 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 12: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=22 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 13: *crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 4 times, $14 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 14: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 15: 14 db , place a marker, the round now starts here, cut the yarn.
Change to co 1 and work even until the leg measures approx. 16 cm .

## HEAD:

The head is worked from mid back to front towards the snout. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.
Work 4 cs with co 1 and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: *2 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 5: *3 db, 2 db in the next db , rep from * to * the rest of the round $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: $* 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db , rep from * to * the rest of the round $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 7: *5 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=42 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$

Rnd 25: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=66 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 26: *9 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 27: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$, cut the yarn and change to co 3 .
Rnd 28: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 29: *8 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round = 54 db
Rnd 30: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=54 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 31: *7 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 32: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 33: *6 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=42 \mathrm{db}$

## STOMACH:

Worked in co 3 in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.
Work 4 cs and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db *, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: *2 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 5: *3 db, 2 db in the next db *, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db , rep from * to * the rest of the round $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 7: *5 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=42 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8: *6 db, 2 db in the next db*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 9: *7 db, 2 db in the next db , rep from * to * the rest of the round $=54 \mathrm{db}$

## TAIL:

Worked from the bottom up in spiral rounds. It is a good idea to place a marker thread at the beg of the round and let it follow up through the work.
Work 4 cs with co 1 and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: *2 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next db *, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=24 \mathrm{db}$, change to co 2 .
Rnd 5: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: *3 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 7: ${ }^{*} 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db} *$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=36 \mathrm{db}$, change to co 1 , work the rest of the tail in stripes of 3 rounds with co 1 and co 2 .
Rnd 8: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 9: *5 db, 2 db in the next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=42 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10-18: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$ [ 9 rounds]
Rnd 19: *5 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 20-29: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$ ( 10 rounds)
Rnd 30: ${ }^{4} \mathrm{db}$, crochet 2 db tog*, rep fm * to * the rest of the round $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 31-41: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$ (11 rounds)
Rnd 42: *3 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 43-49: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$ [ 7 rounds]
Rnd 50: *2 db, crochet 2 db tog*, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 51-55: 1 db in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$ (5 rounds), cut the yarn

## DARK AREA AROUND THE EYES:

Worked in co 2 from the bottom up in spiral rounds.
Work 6 cs with co 1 .
Rnd 1: Turn, work 4 db starting in the 2nd cs from the hook, you now have 1 st left, work 4 db in this cs and cont working 4 db on the other side of the cs row, work another 2 db in the last/first cs $=14$ db , place a marker thread, this is the start of the round.
Rnd 2: *1 db in each of the first $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in each of the next 3 db * rep from * to * the rest of the round $=20 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}$ in each of the first $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}{ }^{*}$ rep from * to * the rest of the round $=26 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 1 db in the first $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}$ in the next $5 d b, 2 d b$ in the next $d b, 1 d b$ in the next $6 d b, 2 d b$ in the next $d b=30 d b$
End with 1 sls, cut the yarn. Make another in the same way.

## EYE:

Work 4 cs with co 1 and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$, end with 1 sls , cut the yarn

## EARS:

Make a total of 4 ears, 2 in co 1 and 2 in co 2 .
Work back and forth and turn every row with 1 cs .
Work 9 cs, turn
Row 1-8: 8 db
Row 9: Crochet 2 db tog, 4 db , crochet 2 db tog
Row 10: 6 db
Row 11: Crochet 2 db tog, 2 db , crochet 2 db tog


Row 12: 4 db
Row 13: Crochet 2 db tog, 2 db , crochet 2 db tog
Row 14: 3 db , cut the yarn
Now work 1 of each co together with a row of db . Work with co 1 , the ear in co 2 should be towards you.

## SNOUT:

Work 4 cs with co 2 and join with 1 sls in the first cs.
Rnd 1: 6 db in the ring.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in the next db *, rep from * to * the rest of the round $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 1 dn in every $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$, cut the yarn.

## FINISHING:

Fill the body, head and arms and legs with fiber filling.
Sew the snout on the head, put a little fiber filling inside.
Sew the head on the body, hold the body tight to give it shape.
Sew the stomach on the body.
Sew the arms on the body, place the arms approx. 3,5 cm from the head
Sew the legs on the body, let there be 5 cm between the legs.
Sew the tail on the back of the body.
Sew the dark part for the eyes on the head, sew the eyes on the dark part. Embroider a couple of sts in the middle of the eye with co 2.
Sew the ears on the head, let there be 6 cm between, fold the edge of the ears in to shape them.
