DEC:

To work a neat, invisible dec (2 db tog) do as follows: insert the hook into the front loops of the next to db, pull the yarn through the two loops, yo and pull the yarn through the two loops = 1 db dec.

HEAD:

Work a magic ring and work 6 db in the ring with co 1.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 4: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 5: 1 db in each db = 24 db

Round 6: *1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 30 db

Round 7: 1 db in each db = 30 db

Round 8: *1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 36 db

Round 9: 1 db in each db = 36 db

Round 10: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 42 db

Round 11: *1 db in the first 6 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 48 db

Round 12-18: 1 db in each db = 48 db

Round 19: *1 db in the first 6 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 42 db

Round 20: 1 db in each db = 42 db

Round 21: *1 db in the first 5 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 36 db

Round 22: 1 db in each db = 36 db

Work 3 db after the mrk, move the mrk to here, this is now the beg of the round.

Round 23: *1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 30 db

Round 24: *1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 25: *1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 18 db

Put fiber filling in the head.

Round 26: *1 db in the first db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 27: Crochet the db tog 2 and 2 on the entire round = 6 db.

Cut the yarn and seam the hole neatly.

BODY:

Work a magic ring and work 6 db in the ring with co 1.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 4: *1 db in the first 2 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 5: *1 db in the first 3 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 30 db

Round 6: *1 db in the first 4 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 36 db

Work 3 db after the mrk, move the mrk to here, this is now the beg of the round.

Round 7: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 42 db

Round 8: *1 db in the first 6 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 48 db

Round 9: *1 db in the first 7 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 54 db

Round 10: 1 db in each db = 54 db

Round 11: *1 db in the first 8 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 60 db

Round 12-18: 1 db in each db = 60 db

Round 19: *1 db in the first 8 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 54 db

Height approx. 39 cm

YARN

Warm Hearted Fraya
100 % Organic Wool

YARDAGE

Colour 1 150 g
Colour 2 50 g

CROCHET GAUGE

18 fm = 10 cm

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK Size 7 (4½ mm) crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

NOTIONS

120 g fiber filling

Round 20-21: 1 db in each db = 54 db

Round 22: *1 db in the first 7 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 48 db

Round 23-24: 1 db in each db = 48 db

Round 25: *1 db in the first 6 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 42 db

Round 26-27: 1 db in each db = 42 db

Round 28: *1 db in the first 5 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 36 db

Round 29: 1 db in each db = 36 db

Round 30: *1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 30 db

Round 31: 1 db in each db = 30 db

Round 32: *1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 24 db

Round 33: 1 db in each db = 24 db

Cut the yarn. Put fiber filling in the body and sew the head on the body.

EARS:

Work 26 cs with co 2, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook. 16 db, 8 htr and in the last cs 5 htr. Cont around the end, 8 htr, 16 db = 53 sts. Turn by working 1 cs.

14 db, 10 htr, 2 htr in each of the next 5 sts, 10 htr, 14 db = 58 sts, cut the yarn.

Crochet another ear in the same way.

Work 26 cs with co 1, turn and start in the 2nd cs from the hook. 16 db, 8 htr and in the last cs 5 htr. Cont around the end, 8 htr, 16 db = 53 sts. Turn by working 1 cs.

14 db, 10 htr, 2 htr in each of the next 5 sts, 10 htr, 14 db = 58 sts, do not cut the yarn.

Work 1 cs. Place an ear in co 1 and an ear in co 2 on top of each other, WS against WS with the ear in co 1 on top. Now crochet through both layers with db so that they are crochet tog. Cut the yarn but leave an end long enough to sew on the ear. Make another ear in the same way.

Sew the ears on the head with small, invisible sts.

LEGS:

Sole: work 9 cs in co 2 and start with the 2nd cs from the hook. 7 db, 5 db in the last cs, cont around the edge, 7 db, and in the db that was made at first work 5 db = 24 sts. Place a mrk, this is the beg of the round.

Round 1: 8 db, 2 db in the next db x 3, 9 db, 2 db in the next db x 3, 1 db = 30 db.

Round 2: 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 12 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 2 db = 34 db.

Round 3: 10 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 12 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 1 db, 2 db in the next db, 2 db = 40 db.

1 sls, cut the yarn. Crochet another sole in the same way.

With co 1 start at the end of the sole - this is the back of the leg and the beg on the round. Pull the yarn through a st and work 1 cs, this is the first st on the round. Work 39 db, place a mrk, the round now starts here.

Round 2-4: 1 db in each db = 40 db.

Round 5: 12 db, crochet 2 db tog x 8, 12 db = 32 db

Round 6: 10 db, crochet 2 db tog x 6, 10 db = 26 db

Round 7: 9 db, crochet 2 db tog x 4, 9 db = 22 db

Round 8: 8 db, crochet 2 db tog x 3, 8 db = 19 db

Round 9: 8 db, crochet 2 db tog, 9 db = 18 db

Round 10: 1 db in each db = 18 db.

Round 11: *1 db in the first 5 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 21 db

Round 12: *1 db in the first 6 db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 24 db

Now work an elevation on one side.

Left side:

Round 1: From the mrk where the round starts work 1 db, 2 htr, 6 tr, 2 htr, 13 db.

Round 2: 2 htr, 6 tr, 3 htr, 13 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 4 times, 16 db, 1 sls, cut the yarn.

Leave a yarn end that is long enough to sew on the leg.

Right side:

Round 1: 13 db, 2 htr, 6 tr, 2 htr, 1 db.

Round 2: 13 db, 3 htr, 6 tr, 2 htr.

Round 3: 16 db, *2 db in the next db, 1 db in the next db* rep from * to * a total of 4 times, 1 sls, cut the yarn.

Leave a yarn end that is long enough to sew on the leg. Fill the legs with fiber filling. Shape the legs and sew them on the body so that the rabbit can sit.



ARMS:

Work a magic ring and work 6 db in the ring with co 1.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 4-9: 1 db in each db = 18 db

Round 10: *1 db in the first 4 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 15 db

Round 11-14: 1 db in each db = 15 db

Round 15: *1 db in the first 3 db, crochet 2 db tog * rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 16-19: 1 db in each db = 12 db

Cut the yarn, but let the yarn end be long enough to use for sewing on the arm. Crochet another arm in the same way. Fill a bit of fiber filling in the end of the arms and sew them on the body.

TAIL:

Work a magic ring and work 6 db in the ring with co 1.

Round 2: 2 db in each db = 12 db.

Round 3: *1 db in the first db, 2 db in the next db* rep from * to * = 18 db

Round 4: 1 db in each db = 18 db

Round 5: *1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 12 db

Round 6: *1 db in the first 2 db, crochet 2 db tog* rep from * to * = 8 db

Cut the yarn, put a bit of fiber filling in the tail. Sew on the back of the rabbit, place it so that the rabbit can sit. Embroider eyes, snout and mouth with co 2. See drawing on the front page.
