BOTTOM:

Star with the tail fin.

1st side of the fin.

If nothing else is stated turn all rows by working 1 cs.

Work 4 cs, turn.

Row 1: 3 db, start from the 2nd db cs from the hook, turn

Row 2: 1 inc, 2 db, turn

Row 3: 3 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 4: 1 inc, 4 db, turn

Row 5: 5 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 6: 1 inc, 6 db, turn

Row 7: 7 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 8: 1 inc, 8 db, turn

Row 9: 1 inc, 7 db, inc, turn

2nd side of the fin:

Work 4 cs, turn.

Row 1: 3 db, start from the 2nd db cs from the hook, turn

Row 2: 2 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 3: 1 inc, 3 db, turn

Row 4: 4 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 5: 1 inc, 5 db, turn

Row 6: 6 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 7: 1 inc, 7 db, turn

Row 8: 8 db, 1 inc, turn

Row 9: 1 inc, 7 db, inc, turn

Now crochet the 2 fins tog.

Row 10: 1 dec, 8 db, 2 cs, 8 db on the other fin, 1 dec, turn.

Row 11: 1 dec, 16 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 12: 1 dec, 14 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 13: 1 dec, 12 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 14: 1 dec, 10 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 15: 1 dec, 8 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 16: 10 db, turn

Length: 32 cm

YARN

Colourful Fraya

100 % Cotton

50 g = 170 m

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

Colourful Fraya:

UK size 13-12 (2½ mm) crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

Fiber filling approx. 100/75 g, scrap yarn for eyes

Row 17: 1 inc, 8 db, 1 inc, turn
Row 18-19: 12 db, turn

Worked as the bottom from the 1st to the 16th row.

Row 85: 1 db in the 2nd db, 4 db, 1 sls
 Crochet a round of db around the entire top, end with 1 sls, cut the yarn.



Crochet the top and the bottom together with a round of db, start with the tailfin, let the top be on top when crocheting the 2 parts tog.

Before finishing the round fill the whale with fiber filling, do not put filling in the tailfin, you can sew tog the tailfin so that filling will not get in there.

FIN:

Work 11 cs, turn

Row 1: 10 db, start from the 2nd db cs from the hook, turn

Row 2: 1 dec, 6 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 3: 8 db, turn

Row 4: 1 dec, 4 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 5: 6 db, turn

Row 6: 1 dec, 2 db, 1 dec, turn

Row 7: 4 db, turn

Row 8: 1 dec, 1 dec, turn

Row 9: 1 dec, cut the yarn, crochet another fin in the same way.

Now crochet a row of db on the 2 sides of the fin [not the cs row side], at the point crochet 3 db in the same st, cont crocheting around the same fin in the same way. Now crochet the 2 fins tog, cut the yarn but leave a yarn end long enough to sew on the fin on the whale.

Crochet another fin in the same way.

FINISHING:

Sew the fins on the whale, see front.

Embroider the eyes on the whale, see front.
