## PATTERN

## HEAD

Worked using colour 1.
The head is worked from the nose to the back of the head.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 24 db
Rnd 5: *1 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to ${ }^{*}$ a total of 12 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: 36 db
Rnd 7: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, *2 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8: 48 db
Rnd 9: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 12 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10: 60 db
Rnd 11: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 11 times, 2 db
$=72 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 12-19: 72 db [8 rnds]
Rnd 20: $7 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 14 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $31 \mathrm{db}=69 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 21: *13 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times, $24 \mathrm{db}=66 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 22: $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *12 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $30 \mathrm{db}=63 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 23: *11 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times, $24 \mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 24: $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 10 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $29 \mathrm{db}=57 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 25: *9 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times, $24 \mathrm{db}=54 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 26: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 8 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $28 \mathrm{db}=51 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 27: *7 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times, $24 \mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 28-32: 48 db [ 5 rnds ]
Rnd 33: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $3 \mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 34: *5 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Start stuffing the head with fibre filling.
Rnd 35: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog , rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 36: *3 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 37: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Stuff the head a bit more before closing it up.
Rnd 38: *1 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 39: *2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off and close the gap by weaving the tail through the last rnd of db .

## BODY

Worked using colour 1.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 24 db
Rnd 5: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 12 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: 36 db
Rnd 7: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, *2 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8: 48 db
Rnd 9: *3 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 12 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10: 60 db
Rnd 11: *9 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=66 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 12-17: 66 db ( 6 rnds)

## MEASUREMENTS

Height: approx. 20 cm

## YARN

Colourful Fraya
100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=170 \mathrm{~m}$

## YARDAGE

Main colour: colour $1 \quad 50-60 \mathrm{~g}$
Footpads: colour $2 \quad 10 \mathrm{~g}$
Spots: scraps in 2 different colours
Scraps of black and white for the eyes

## CROCHET GAUGE

$26 \mathrm{db} \times 26 \mathrm{rnds}=10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 12 ( 2.5 mm ] crochet hook

Please note: To get a nice, dense fabric, it is important to get gauge. If needed, try with a bigger or smaller hook.

## NOTIONS

Fibre filling, approx. 150 g

Rnd 18: *9 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 19: 60 db
Rnd 20: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *8 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $4 \mathrm{db}=54 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 21: 54 db
Rnd 22: *7 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 23: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *6 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $3 \mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 24: $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, * $12 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $6 \mathrm{db}=39 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 25: *11 db, 2 db tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 3 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Start stuffing the body with fibre filling.
Rnd 26: $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 10 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $5 \mathrm{db}=33 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 27: *9 db, 2 db tog ${ }^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 3 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 28-29: 30 db [2 rnds]
Rnd 30: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 8 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $4 \mathrm{db}=27 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 31-32: 27 db (2 rnds)
Rnd 33: *7 db, 2 db tog*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 34: 24 db
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the body a bit more, and, if needed, rep this when assembling.

## LEGS X 2

Begin with colour 2.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 24 db
Rnd 5: *1 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 12 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Change to colour 1 .
Rnd 6: 36 db
Rnd 7: 36 db in the back loop only
Rnd 8-11: 36 db [ 4 rnds]
Rnd 12: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 13: $6 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times, $6 \mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$ Start stuffing the foot with fibre filling.
Rnd 14: $3 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times, $3 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 15-18: 18 db ( 4 rnds)
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the leg with fibre filling, and, if needed, stuff it a bit more when assembling.

## ARMS $\mathbf{X} 2$

Worked using colour 1.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times $=9 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3-10: 9 db
Fold the arm and close the opening with 4 db . Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff.

## NOSTRILS X 2

Worked using colour 1.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: 12 db
Fold the nostril and close the opening with 5 db . Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff.

## TAIL

Worked using colour 1.
Rnd 1: 4 db in a magic ring $=4 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 4 db
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 2 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 6 db
Rnd 5: *2 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 2 times $=8 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: 8 db
Rnd 7: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 2 times $=10 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8: 10 db
Rnd 9: *4 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10: 12 db
Rnd 11: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 3 times $=15 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 12: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 2 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 13: *5 db, 2 db in next db *, rep from * to * a total of 3 times $=21 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff it when assembling.


EYES X 2
Begin with black.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Change to white.
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$ Rnd 5-6: 24 db [2 rnds]
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff it when assembling.

## SPOTS

Worked in 3 sizes and in 2 colours.
Large x 2 :
Work 1 in each colour.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, rep from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
Medium $\times 2$ :
Work 1 in each colour.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in each $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
Small x 2:
Work 1 in each colour.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

## Head:

Sew the eyes onto rnd 24-32 of the head on the opposite side of the decreases on rnd 20-27. Place the eyes with approx. 8-9 db between them. Remember to stuff.
Then sew the nostrils onto rnd 10-13. Place them parallel to the eyes but slightly tilted. They should curve a bit and lie down after sewing.

## Body:

Start by sewing the legs onto rnd 7-13 of the body, 12 db apart.
Then sew the tail onto the back between rnd 9-15.
Sew a slightly tilted arm onto each side of the body between rnd 32-33.
Now join head and body. The body is sewn onto rnd 35-31 of the head. Stuff the body with some more fibre filling.
Sew the spots onto the back.
