All parts are crocheted in the rnd in a continuous spiral. Marking the beginning of the rnd with a stitch marker or a marker thread is very helpful.

## HEAD

Worked in brown.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *2 db in every db *, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: 24 db
Rnd 5: *1 db, 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: 36 db
Rnd 7: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, 1 db $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8: 48 db
Rnd 9: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10-23: 60 db [14 rnds]
Rnd 24: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 25: 48 db
Rnd 26: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 27: *1 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, and weave in ends. Stuff the head so it is firm but still soft and the fabric dense.

Worked in brown.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: * $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4 : $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, 1 db $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 5: *3 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, 2 db $=36 \mathrm{db}$

Rnd 26: ${ }^{*} 15 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$

Rnd 33: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *8 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $4 \mathrm{db}=27 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 34: *7 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 35-36: 24 db [2 rnds]
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the rest of the body so it is firm but still soft and the fabric dense.

Warm Hearted Fraya
100\% Organic Wool
$50 \mathrm{~g}=100 \mathrm{~m}$

## YARDAGE

Brown: 150 g
Nature: 30 g
Dark grey mélange: 10 g
SUGGESTED HOOK SIZE
UK size 7 [ 4.5 mm ] crochet hook

Note: It is important to get a nice, dense fabric. If needed, try with a bigger or smaller hook.

## NOTIONS

Approx. 110 g fibre filling, stitch marker

## ARM X2

Worked in brown.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4-5: 18 db [2 rnds]
Rnd 6: *2 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, *1 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from *
to * a total of 3 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 7-8: 18 db [2 rnds]
Rnd 9: *2 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $9 \mathrm{db}=21 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 10-19: 21 db [10 rnds]
Rnd 20: 3 db, *2 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $6 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Stuff the arm lightly. Only the first half of the arm needs filling
Rnd 21-22: 18 db [2 rnds]
Rnd 23: $3 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $6 \mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 24: 15 db
Rnd 25: 3 db , *2 db toq*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $6 \mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 26: *2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Close the opening by sewing the last db tog.

## LEG X2

Begin in nature.
Rnd 1: 6 cs in nature, turn and begin in 2nd cs from the hook, $4 \mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}$ in the last $\mathrm{cs}, 3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in the cs from the beginning $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in next db, 3 db, *2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, 3 db, *2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, 3 db , *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, 3 db, *2 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, 3 db , *2 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Change to brown.
Rnd 5: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, 3 db, *3 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, 3 db , *3 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6-9: 36 db [4 rnds]
Rnd 10: * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 11: $4 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times, $8 \mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 12: $4 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 4 times, $8 \mathrm{db}=20 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 13-15: 20 db [3 rnds]
Stuff the foot.
Rnd 16: * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 4 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 17-24: 24 db [8 rnds]
Rnd 25: *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 26: 18 db
Stuff the rest of the leg.
Rnd 27: *1 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 28: *2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Close the opening by sewing the last db tog.

## MUZZLE

Worked in brown.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4 : $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db},{ }^{* 2} \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=24$ db

Rnd 5: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 6: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=36$ db
Rnd 7: *5 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=42 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 8-11: 42 db [ 4 rnds]
Rnd 12: *5 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 13: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 14: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 15: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 16: *1 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 17: *2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Close the opening by sewing the last db tog. Do not stuff.


## EAR X2

Worked in brown.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 3: *1 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 4: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=24$ db
Rnd 5-8: 24 db [4 rnds]
Fold the ear, and crochet it tog with approx. 10-11 db. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Do not stuff.

## EYEX2

Begin in dark grey mélange.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a magic ring $=6 \mathrm{db}$
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$
Change to nature, leaving a tail long enough to embroider the line in the eye.
Rnd 3: *1 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Embroider the line in the eye from the middle to the small gap between rnd 2 and 3 .

## FINISHING

Begin by assembling the head:
Fold the muzzle around itself, creating a hollow hemisphere. Using dark grey mélange, embroider a nose from rnd 8 and up and around rnd 7. Make sure to embroider roughly in the middle.
Sew the muzzle on to rnd 15-24 of the head. Remember to stuff before fastening off.
Now sew the eyes on to the head above the muzzle, approx. over rnd 10-14 and with approx. 5 db between them.
Fold the ears around themselves in the same way, making the layers lie double. Then sew an ear on to rnd 7-14 on each side of the head. Make sure they curve slightly.

Then assemble the body:
Sew an arm on to rnd 26-30 on each side of the body. Sew around the top of the arm, creating an "armpit". Make sure the side with the decreases is facing the body.
Sew the legs on to the body by "mashing" the last 8 rnds or so up against the underside of the body. Pin them in position so they stay in place when sewing. Now sew around the leg so that the 8th rnd from last gets attached to rnd $4-5$ of the body and the last rnd gets attached to rnd 10 of the body.

Attach the head to the body.
