## BOBBLE STITCH

Wrap the yarn over the hook and pull up a loop = 3 loops on the hook. Wrap the yarn over the hook and pull it through the first 2 loops. Repeat this a total of 4 times in the same st. For each repeat you get an additional loop on the hook - you will end up with 5 loops. Wrap the yarn over the hook again and pull it through all 5 loops. The bobble will show on the opposite side - push it to the right side when you work the next db.

## PATTERN

Work with yarn held double. Throughout, one strand is dropped and another picked up to create an ombre effect.

## HEAD AND BODY

Work top-down, beginning with the head, then the body.
Begin with 2 colour 1 strands.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 4: 24 db .
Rnd 5: * $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 6: 36 db .
Rnd 7: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=$ 48 db .
Rnd 8-10: 48 db (3 rnds).
Rnd 11: *7 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=54 \mathrm{db}$.
Drop a colour 1 strand and pick up a colour 2 strand.
Rnd 12-13: 54 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 14: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 8 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db *, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $4 \mathrm{db}=$ 60 db .
Rnd 15-16: 60 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 17: *9 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to ${ }^{*}$ a total of 6 times $=66 \mathrm{db}$.
Drop the other colour 1 strand and pick up another colour 2 strand.
Rnd 18-19: 66 db [ 2 rnds].
Rnd 20: $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 10 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db *, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $5 \mathrm{db}=$ 72 db .
Rnd 21-23: 72 db [3 rnds].
Drop a colour 2 strand and pick up a colour 3 strand.
Rnd 24-25: 72 db .
Rnd 26: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 27: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 28: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 29: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$.
Drop the other colour 2 strand and pick up another colour 3 strand.
Rnd 30: 30 db in FLO.
Rnd 31: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=$ 36 db .
Rnd 32: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, *2 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=$ 48 db .
Rnd 33: 48 db .
Rnd 34: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 35: 60 db .
Drop a colour 3 strand and pick up a colour 2 strand.

## SUGGESTED HOOK SIZE

UK size 9 [ 3.5 mm ] crochet hook

NOTE: The fabric needs to be nice and tight.

## NOTIONS

Fibre filling, approx. 300 g

## \#BIBITHEBIRD

Rnd 36-38: 60 db [3 rnds].
Rnd 39: *9 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=66 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 40-41: 66 db [2 rnds].
Drop the other colour 3 strand and pick up another colour 2 strand.
Rnd 42 : $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 10 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $5 \mathrm{db}=$ 72 db .
Rnd 43-47: 72 db [5 rnds].
Drop a colour 2 strand and pick up a colour 1 strand.
Rnd 48-49: 72 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 50: $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, ${ }^{*} 10 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $5 \mathrm{db}=66 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 51-52: 66 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 53: *9 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=60 \mathrm{db}$.
Stuff the head.
Drop the other colour 2 strand and pick up another colour 1 strand.
Rnd 54: 60 db .
Rnd 55: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 56: 48 db .
Rnd 57: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=36 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 58: 36 db .
Stuff the body.
Rnd 59: *1 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 60: *2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 61: *2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Fasten off, and weave the tail through the remaining sts and pull tight to close.

## WINGS X2

Begin with 2 colour 4 strands.
Work in BLO.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: *2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: 12 db .
Drop a colour 4 strand and pick up a colour 2 strand.
Rnd 4: *5 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=14 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 5: *6 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=16 \mathrm{db}$.
Drop the other colour 4 strand and pick up another colour 2 strand.
Rnd 6: *7 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 7: *8 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=20 \mathrm{db}$.
Drop a colour 2 strand and pick up a colour 3 strand.
Rnd 8: *9 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=22 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 9: 22 db .
Flatten the opening and close it with 10 db . Do not stuff. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

## WING FEATHERS

Now, crochet wing feathers with cs.
Begin with 2 colour 4 strands.
Pull up a loop in the first db worked in the mr of the wing. Work 1 db in this st.
*10 cs, 1 sls in next 2 db *, repeat from * to * a total of 15 times $=15$ feathers.
Drop a colour 4 strand and pick up a colour 2 strand.
*10 cs, 1 sls in next 2 db *, repeat from * to * a total of 15 times $=15$ feathers.
Drop the other colour 4 strand and pick up another colour 2 strand.
${ }^{*} 10 \mathrm{cs}, 1$ sls in next $2 \mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 19 times $=19$ feathers.
Drop a colour 2 strand and pick up a colour 3 strand.
*10 cs, 1 sls in next $2 \mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 10 times, $10 \mathrm{cs}, 1$ sls in next $\mathrm{db}=11$ feathers.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

## BELLY

Use 2 colour 2 strands.
Row 1: 7 cs, turn.
Row 2: Begin in 2nd cs from hook: 2 db in next db, $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}=9 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 3: 1 cs , turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=3 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 4 : 1 cs, turn, 2 db in next db, $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 5: 1 cs , turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=4 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 6: 1 cs, turn, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}, 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 7: 1 cs , turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 4 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=5 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 8: 1 cs, turn, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}, 6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 9: 1 cs , turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}$, 2 db , repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=6 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 10: 1 cs , turn, 18 db .


Row 11: 1 cs, turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=6 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 12: 1 cs , turn, 18 db .
Row 13: 1 cs , turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=6 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 14: 1 cs , turn, 2 db tog, $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog $=15 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 15: 1 cs, turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 4 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=5 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 16: 1 cs, turn, 2 db tog, $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, $5 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog $=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 17: 1 cs, turn, $1 \mathrm{db},{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{bs}, 2 \mathrm{db}$, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $1 \mathrm{bs}, 1 \mathrm{db}=4 \mathrm{bs}$.
Row 18: 1 cs , turn, 12 db .
Now, crochet around the belly. Work *1 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$ in the row-ends and 1 db in every db along the top and bottom.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## TUFTS X2

Begin with 2 colour 4 strands.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: *2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: * $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 4: 18 db .
Rnd 5: *5 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=21 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 6: 21 db .
Drop a colour 4 strand and pick up a colour 1 strand.
Rnd 7-9: 21 db [3 rnds].
Rnd 10: *5 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Drop the other colour 4 strand and pick up another colour 1 strand.
Rnd 11-12: 18 db [ 2 rnds ].
Rnd 13: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 14-15: 15 db [2 rnds).
Rnd 16: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Stuff lightly, flatten the opening and close it with db. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## BEAK

Use 2 colour 5 strands.
Rnd 1: 6 db in a $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 6 db .
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=9 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd $4: 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=$ 12 db .
Rnd 5: 12 db .
Rnd 6: *3 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=15 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 7: 15 db .
Rnd 8: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=$ 18 db .
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing and embroidering.

## FLOWER

Begin with 2 colour 4 strands.
Row 1: 25 cs, turn.
Row 2: Begin in 2nd cs from hook: *1 db, 4 tr in next st, $1 \mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 8 times. Fold into a rose and sew it together so it holds its shape.

## TAIL

The tail is initially worked as 3 parts that are joined together later on. Work 1 part at a time. Start by working a colour 3 part, a colour 1 part, and a colour 4 part. Do not fasten off on the colour 4 part.

## Use 2 colour 3 strands

Row 1: 7 cs, turn.
Row 2: Begin in 2nd cs from hook: 2 db in next cs, $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next cs, 1 cs , turn $=8 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 3: *31 cs, turn. Begin in 2nd cs from hook: 2 db in every cs, 1 sls in next db, 1 sls in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times.
Row 4: 31 cs , turn. Begin in 2nd cs from hook: 2 db in every cs, 1 sls in next næste db .
Fasten off, and weave in the ends.
Use 2 colour 1/colour 4 strands
Row 1: 7 cs , turn.
Row 2: Begin in 2nd cs from hook: $6 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{cs}$, turn $=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 3: *31 cs, turn. Begin in 2nd cs from hook: 2 db in every cs, 1 sls in next db, 1 sls in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times.


Row 4: 31 cs, turn. Begin in 2nd cs from hook: 2 db in every cs, 1 sls in next db.
Fasten off and weave in the ends on the colour 1 part.
After crocheting the colour 4 part, the 3 parts are joined together. Place the colour 1 part at the bottom, the colour 3 part in the middle, and the colour 4 part at the top, making sure that the foundation chains are lined up. Join with 6 db .
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## ASSEMBLY

Sew the belly to rnd 54-34 of the body with the 3 bs at the top.
Sew on the beak above the belly, to rnd 18-23 of the head. Remember to stuff the beak before closing the seam. Use the remaining tail to embroider closed eyes.
Sew the tufts to the top of the head, over rnd 5-6 behind the mr. Make sure that they are tilting backwards. Now, place the flower in a diagonal line from the tufts and sew it on.
Place the wings over rnd $35-40$ at an angle and sew them to each side of the body.
Now, sew the tail to the back, over rnd 48. The blue part should be on top.
