Start with black.
Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 2 db in next $2 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $2 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{db}=10 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $2 \mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}=14 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 4: 14 db .
Rnd 5: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, 2 db tog, $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, 2 db tog, $2 \mathrm{db}=10 \mathrm{db}$.
Change to nature.
Rnd 6: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times $=15 \mathrm{db}$.

Rnd 20: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 8 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $4 \mathrm{db}=60 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 21-30: 60 db [10 rnds].
Stuff the head.
Rnd 31: $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *8 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $4 \mathrm{db}=54 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 32: *7 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=48 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 33: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *6 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $3 \mathrm{db}=42 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 34: *5 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$.
Stuff the head a bit more.
Rnd 35: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 36: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 37: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$.

Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 4: 24 db .
Rnd 5: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 12 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 6: 36 db .
Rnd 7: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 11 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=48 \mathrm{db}$.

## SUGGESTED HOOK SIZE

UK size 12 [ 2.5 mm ] crochet hook

Please note: It is important to obtain gauge. The work should have a close texture. Try with a smaller or larger needle if necessary.

## NOTIONS

Approx. 60 g fibre filling

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Rnds 8-15: 48 db [8 rnds].
Rnd 16: $7 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *14 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $7 \mathrm{db}=45 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 17-18: 45 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 19: *13 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=42 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 20-21: 42 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 22: *5 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=36 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 23: 36 db .
Rnd 24: $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, * $4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=30 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 25: 30 db .
Rnd 26: *3 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 27-28: 24 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 29: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *6 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $3 \mathrm{db}=21 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 30-31: 21 db [2 rnds].
Rnd 32: *5 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 33: 18 db .
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the body.

## ARM x 2

Worked in black.
Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 4 : $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 5-9: 24 db ( 5 rnds).
Rnd 10: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 11-16: 18 db ( 6 rnds).
Rnd 17: 2 db tog, $16 \mathrm{db}=17 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 18-21: 17 db [ 4 rnds].
Rnd 22: 2 db tog, $15 \mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 23-26: 16 db (4 rnds).
Rnd 27: 2 db tog, $14 \mathrm{db}=15 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 28-29: 15 db [2 rnds].
Stuff the arm lightly.
Rnd 30: 2 db , flatten the opening, and crochet tog with 7 db .
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FOOT $x 2$

Worked in black.
Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 4: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, * 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $2 \mathrm{db}=24 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 5-8: 24 db [4 rnds].
Rnd 9: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 10-14: 18 db (5 rnds).
Rnd 15: *1 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Stuff the foot.
Rnd 16: *2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Close the hole by weaving the tail through the remaining db and tightening.

## LEG $\mathbf{x} 2$

Worked in black.
Rnd 1: Work 6 cs and turn the work.
Rnd 2: Start in 2nd cs from the hook: $4 \mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 3-7: 12 db ( 5 rnds).
Rnd 8: *5 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=14 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 9-13: 14 db [ 5 rnds ].
Rnd 14: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, $6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, $3 \mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$
Rnds 15-19: 16 db (5 rnds).
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the leg when assembling.

## EAR $x 2$

Worked in blue.
Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times $=9 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next * $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 4-6: 12 db [3 rnds].
Flatten the opening, and crochet tog with 5 db . Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.


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TAIL
Start with nature.
Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next db, $1 \mathrm{db}=8 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 3: *3 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=10 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd $4: 2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 4 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Change to blue.
Rnd 5: *5 db, 2 db in next $\mathrm{db}^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 2 times $=14 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 6: $3 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 6 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 3 \mathrm{db}=16 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnds 7-9: 16 db [3 rnds].
Rnd 10: $1 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ tog, *2 db, 2 db tog*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, $1 \mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Stuff the tail lightly. Flatten the opening, and crochet tog with 5-6 db. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## MARKING AROUND EYE x 2

Worked in black.
Row 1: Work 2 cs and turn the work.
Row 2: Begin in 2nd cs from the hook: 2 db in next st, 1 cs, turn $=2 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 3: 2 db in next $2 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{cs}$, turn $=4 \mathrm{db}$.
Row 4: $4 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{cs}$, turn.
Row 5: 2 db in next db, $2 \mathrm{db}, 2 \mathrm{db}$ in next $\mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{cs}$, turn $=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rows 6-15: $6 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{cs}$, turn [10 rows].
Row 16: $1 \mathrm{db}, 1 \mathrm{htr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{db}$.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## EYEx 2

Start with black.
Rnd 1: 6 db in $\mathrm{mr}=6 \mathrm{db}$.
Rnd 2: 2 db in every $\mathrm{db}=12 \mathrm{db}$.
Change to white.
Rnd 3: *1 db, 2 db in next db*, repeat from * to * a total of 6 times $=18 \mathrm{db}$.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. With white yarn, embroider a highlight in the eye.

## SCARF

Worked in a colour to your liking
Row 1: Work 72 cs and turn the work.
Row 2: Begin in 3rd cs from the hook: 70 htr, 2 cs, turn.
Row 3: 70 htr, 2 cs, turn.
Row 4: 70 htr .
Fasten off, and weave in the ends.

## ASSEMBLY

Make sure that the wide part of the snout is horizontal when assembling.
Begin by sewing the eyes onto the markings, over approx. rows $7-13$ with at least 1 db on either side. Now, sew the markings onto the head, over rnds $9-27$ with 3 db between the tips [closest to the snout] and approx. 7-8 db between the wide ends.
Sew the ears onto the head, over rnd 28 right behind the markings.
Sew the arms onto the body, over rnd 30 at a slight angle towards rnds 29 and 28. Make sure that the decreases on the arm face backwards.
Now, sew the legs onto the feet, over rnds 11-15. Make sure that the legs turn so that rnd 1 aligns horizontally with the sts of the feet. Stuff the legs lightly before sewing them onto the body.
Sew the legs onto the bottom of the body, over rnds 2-5.
Sew the tail onto the back of the body, over rnd 10.
Finally, sew the head onto the body. Make sure that the snout faces forward. The body is sewn onto the head over rnds 18-23. Stuff the neck a bit more before closing the seam.
Wrap the scarf around the neck of the badger - now it is ready for adventures.
