

ABBREVIATIONS:

st[s] = stitch(es) beq = beginning = knit = increase(s), pick up the thread k inc between 2 sts and k it tbl. = purl = continue = marker mrk cont = repeat = remain rem rep = pattern RS = right side patt

CABLE RIGHT 6 STS: Place 3 sts on the cable needle to the back, k3, k the 3 sts from the cable needle.

WS

= wrong side

CABLE LEFT 6 STS: Place 3 sts on the cable needle to the front, k3, k the 3 sts from the cable needle.

BACK:

tbl

st st

On the UK size 7 ($4\frac{1}{2}$ mm) needles cast on 104 (112) 120 (130) 140 sts and work rib, k1, p1. Work a total of 11 rows of rib

Switch to UK size 6 [5 mm] needles.

= through the back loop

= stocking stitch

Row 1-4: Work in st st starting with a RS row.

Row 5: K1 (5) 0 (5) 1, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6* rep from * to * until 13 (17) 12 (17) 13 sts rem, cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k1 (5) 0 (5) 1.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7-10: St st.

Size S

Row 11: K10, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6* rep from * to * until the last 4 sts, k4.

Row 12: Purl.

Size M

Row 11: K2, cable left 6 sts, k6, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6*, rep from * to * until 8 sts rem, cable right 6 sts, k2.

Row 12: Purl.

Size L

Row 11: K9, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6* rep from * to * until the last 3 sts, k3.

Row 12: Purl.

Size XL

Row 11: K2, cable left 6 sts, k6, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6*, rep from * to * until 8 sts rem, cable right 6 sts, k2.

Row 12: Purl.

Size XXL

Row 11: K10, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6* rep from * to * until the last 4 sts, k4.

Row 12: Purl.

Row 1-12 makes up the cable patt. Work until the work measures 47 cm and cast off for armholes on both sides for 4-3-2-1-1-1 sts = 80 [88] 96 [106] 116 sts

SIZES

S(M)L(XL)XXL

MEASUREMENTS

½ Chest: 47 [51] 55 [59] 63 cm Length: 72 [73] 74 [75] 76 cm

YARN

Merry Fraya 100 % Merino Wool 50 g = 100 m

YARDAGE

800 (850) 900 (950) 1000 g

GAUGE

22 sts and 22 rows to 10 x 10 cm in patt on size 5,0 mm needles.

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 7 and 6 [4½ and 5 mm] needles, UK size 7 and 6 [4½ and 5 mm] circular needles 40 cm, cable needle

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

Cable needle, stitch holders

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Work even in patt until the armhole measures 21 (22) 23 (24) 25 cm. Now cast off for shoulder and neck at the same time. Cast off for shoulder from the armhole side on every 2nd row for 5-5-6-6 sts (6-6-6-6 sts) 6-6-7-7 sts (7-7-7-8 sts) 8-8-8-8 sts. At the same time place the middle 30 (34) 38 (42) 46 sts on a st holder for the neckline and finish each side separately. Cast off on the neck side on every 2nd row for another 2-1 sts.

FRONT:

Worked in the same way as the back but with a lower neckline.

When the armhole measures 18 cm place the middle 10 (14) 18 (22) 26 sts on a st holder for the neckline and finish each side separately. Cast off on the neck side on every 2nd row for another 4-3-2-1-1-1 sts. Cast off for shoulders at the same length and in the same way as on the back.

SLEEVES:

On the UK size 7 $[4\frac{1}{2}$ mm] needles cast on 52 [52] 52 [60] 60 sts and work rib, k1, p1. Work a total of 11 rows of rib.

Switch to the UK size 6 (5 mm) needles and cont in patt while at the same time inc 1 st on both sides on every 6th row.

Row 1-4: Work in st st starting with a RS row.

Row 5: K2 [2] 2 [6] 6, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6* rep from * to * until the last 14 [14] 14 [18] 18 sts, cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k2 [2] 2 [6] 6.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7-10: St st.

Sizes S (M) L

Row 11: K12, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6* rep from * to * end the last rep with k12.

Row 12: Purl

Sizes XL (XXL)

Row 11: K4, cable left 6 sts, k6, *cable right 6 sts, cable left 6 sts, k6*, rep from * to * until 10 sts rem, cable right 6 sts, k4.

Row 12: Purl

Row 1-12 makes up the cable patt. Cont in patt with inc as described until there are a total of 84 [84] 84 [92] 92 sts.

Work even in patt until the sleeve measures 53 cm and cast off for the armhole on both sides on every 2nd row for 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 16 [16] 16 [20] 20 times, 2 sts twice and 3 sts once. Cast off the rem 20 sts. Knit another sleeve in the same way. Seam the shoulder seam.

NECKLINE:

With the UK size 7 ($4\frac{1}{2}$ mm) circular needles knit the resting 30 (34) 38 (42) 46 sts of the neck of the back, pick up 26 sts along the neck from here and to the neck of the front, knit the resting 10 (14) 18 (22) 26 sts of the neck of the front and pick up 26 sts along the neck to the beg of the neck of the back = 92 (100) 108 (116) 124 sts. Work rib, k1, p1, a total of 9 rounds and cast off on the 10th row.

FINISHING:

Weave in the ends and block lightly. Sew on the sleeves and seam the sleeve and side seams.
