# lazy sunday blanket

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**ABBREVIATIONS:****st(s)** = stitch(es)**k** = knit**p** = purl**patt** = pattern**st st** = stocking stitch**yo** = yarn over**tog** = together**tbl** = through the back loop**rep** = repeat**rem** = remaining**GAUGE SWATCH:**

The patt is divisible by 9 sts.

Cast on 35 sts on the UK size 7 [4½ mm] needle with double yarn.

**Row 1:** Work in rib, k1, p1, end with k1.**Row 2:** Work in rib patt and end with p1.

Rep row 1 and 2.

**Row 5:** K1, p1, k3, \*yo, k2, k2togtbl, k2tog, k2, yo, k1\*, rep from \* to \* until 3 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1, k1.**Row 6:** P1, k1, p until 2 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1.**Row 7:** K1, p1, k2, \*yo, k2, k2togtbl, k2tog, k2, yo, k1\* rep from \* to \* until 4 sts rem on the needle, k2, p1, k1.**Row 8:** P1, k1, p until 2 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1.

Rep rows 5 to 8 a total of 6 times, cast off the sts.

The gauge swatch should measure approx. 19 cm in width and 10 cm in height.

**PLAID:** Size approx. 140 cm x 195 cm

Yarn use: Fine Wool 20 balls of 50 g

Cast on 233 sts on the UK size 7 [4½ mm] needles with double yarn.

**Row 1:** Work in rib, k1, p1, end with k1.**Row 2:** Work in rib patt, start and end with p1.

Rep rows 1 and 2.

**Row 5:** K1, p1, k3, \*yo, k2, k2togtbl, k2tog, k2, yo, k1\*, rep from \* to \* until 3 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1, k1.**Row 6:** P1, k1, p until 2 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1.**Row 7:** K1, p1, k2, \*yo, k2, k2togtbl, k2tog, k2, yo, k1\* rep from \* to \* until 4 sts rem on the needle, k2, p1, k1.**Row 8:** P1, k1, p until 2 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1.

Rep rows 5 to 8 until the plaid measures 194 cm.

Work 3 rows of rib, cast off in rib.

**MEASUREMENTS**

140x195 cm/70 x 98 cm

**YARN**

Mindful Fraya

100% Wool

50 g = 350 m

**YARDAGE**

1000 g/250 g

**GAUGE**

2 patt rep measures 11 cm in width in double yarn

The plaid is worked back and forth on circular needles since all the sts will not fit on straight needles

**SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE**UK size 7 [4½ mm] circular needles  
80 cm

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

**PLAID:** Size approx. 70 cm x 98 cm

Yarn use: Fine Wool 5 balls of 50 g

Cast on 116 sts on the UK size 7 [4½ mm] needles with double yarn.

**Row 1:** Work in rib, k1, p1, end with k1.

**Row 2:** Work in rib patt

Rep rows 1 and 2.

**Row 5:** K1, p1, k3, \*yo, k2, k2togtbl, k2tog, k2, yo, k1\*, rep from \* to \* until 3 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1, k1.

**Row 6:** P1, k1, p until 2 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1.

**Row 7:** K1, p1, k2, \*yo, k2, k2togtbl, k2tog, k2, yo, k1\* rep from \* to \* until 4 sts rem on the needle, k2, p1, k1.

**Row 8:** P1, k1, p until 2 sts rem on the needle, k1, p1.

Rep rows 5 to 8 until the plaid measures 97 cm.

Work 3 rows of rib, cast off in rib.

**FINISHING:**

Weave in the ends, wash the plaid according to the instructions on the tag of the yarn, block to measurements. Let the plaid dry all the way before unblocking.
