

#MISSDOTTEACOSY

miss dot tea cosy



FRAYA[®]

♥ FOR THIS PATTERN YOU WILL BE WORKING WITH 2 COLOURS OF WARM-HEARTED FRAYA –WHICH GIVES A REALLY LOVELY EFFECT. CHANGING COLOURS BACK AND FORTH REQUIRES A BIT OF DEXTERITY, SO A BIT OF EXPERIENCE IS RECOMMENDED. GO, GO, GO!

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ABBREVIATIONS:

st[s] = stitch(es)
 k = knit
 p = purl
 RS = right side

WS = wrong side
 tbl = through the back loop
 tog = together

PATTERN: ["blackberry pattern" divisible by 4]

Cast on 80 sts with colour 1 on UK size 6 [5 mm] needles. Purl 1 row.

Row 1: *With colour 1 work [k1, p1, k1] in the same stitch, p3tog*, repeat from * to * to end of row.

Row 2: Purl with colour 1.

Now work with 2 colours at a time:

Row 3: *P3tog with colour 1, work [k1, p1, k1] in the same stitch with colour 2*, repeat from * to * to end of row. Hold the yarn to the front of the work when changing colour.

Row 4: *P3 with colour 2, p1 with colour 1*, repeat from * to * to end of row. Hold the yarn to the back of the work when changing colour.

Row 5: *Work [k1, p1, k1] in the same stitch with colour 2, p3tog with colour 1* repeat from * to * to end of row. Hold the yarn to the front of the work when changing colour.

Row 6: *P1 with colour 1, p3 with colour 2*, repeat from * to * to end of row. Hold the yarn to the front of the work when changing colour.

Row 3-6 forms the pattern. Repeat these until the work measures 44 cm. Then work 2 rows in colour 1 and bind off all sts.

FINISHING:

Weave in all ends and steam gently. Fold work in half and sew the sides.

LINING:

Cut a piece of fabric for the lining that is 35 cm [the width of the tea cosy + 2 cm seam allowance] x 48 cm [height of the tea cosy].

Cut a piece of Thermolam the same size.

Sew the Thermolam to the WS of the fabric with a 0,5 cm seam allowance.

Fold the fabric in half and sew the sides. Press. At the same time, fold and press 1 cm to the WS along the bottom.

Place the lining inside the finished tea cosy and sew the lining in place along the bottom.

MEASUREMENTS

Width approx. 23 cm

Height approx. 33 cm

YARN

Warm hearted Fraya

100 % organic wool

50 g = 100 m

YARDAGE

colour. 1 100 g

colour. 2 100 g

GAUGE

In the "blackberry pattern" on a UK size 6 [5 mm] needle: 25 sts x 10

rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

The blackberry pattern is very dense.

SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size 6 [5 mm] needles

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.

NOTIONS

50 cm fabric for the lining

50 cm Thermolam
