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ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
r = row

A:

Work 16 ch, turn.

Row 1: Work 15 sc start in 2nd st from hook, turn with 1 ch.

Row 2 - 28: Work 15 sc where you only crochet in the back chain, turn and work 1 ch.

B:

Crochet 21 ch, turn.

Row 1: Work 20 sc start in 2nd st from hook, turn and work 1 ch.

Row 2 - 24: Work 20 sc where you only crochet in the back chain, turn and work 1 ch.

C:

Crochet 4 parts::

PART 1: Work 14 ch, turn

Row 1: Work 13 sc start in 2nd st from hook, turn and work 1 ch.

Row 2 - 10: Work 13 sc where you only crochet in the back chain, turn and work 1 ch.

PART 2: Work 11 ch, turn

Row 1: Work 10 sc start in 2nd st from hook, turn and work 1 ch.

Row 2 - 12: Work 10 sc where you only crochet in the back chain, turn and work 1 ch.

PART 3: Work 8 sc start in 2nd st from hook, turn and work 1 ch.

Row 2 - 12: Work 8 sc where you only crochet in the back chain, turn and work 1 ch.

PART 4: Work 7 ch, turn

Row 1: Work 6 sc start in 2nd st from hook, turn and work 1 ch.

Row 2 - 10: Work 6 sc where you only crochet in the back chain, turn and work 1 ch.

FINISH A+B+C: Snip the yarn, leaving the end long enough to sew the cactus together. Stitch through the rows at one end, pulling it together tightly. Stitch the cactus together and fasten. Fill with fibre filling and place it in a pot of your choice
