## MODEL A:

Cast on 93 sts on UK size $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ [ 3 mm ] needles.
Row 1: *K1, p1*, repeat from * to * to the last stitch, k1.
Row 2: *P1, k1*, repeat from * to * to the last stitch, p1.
Repeat Row 1-2 until a total of 10 rows have been worked.
Row 11: *K1, p1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $\mathrm{k} 6,{ }^{*} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 5 *$, repeat from * to * to the last 11 sts, k1, *p1, k1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times.
Row 12: *P1, k1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, k1, *p5, k1*, repeat from * to * to the last 10 sts, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times.
Row 13: *K1, p1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, k1, *yarn over, k2tog tbl, p1, k2tog, yarn over, k1*, repeat from * to * to the last 10 sts,
*p1, k1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times.
Row 14: *P1, k1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, k1, p2, *k1, p5*, repeat from * to * to the last 14 sts, k1, p2, k1, *k1, p1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times.
Row 15: *K1, $\mathrm{p} 1^{*}$, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, $\mathrm{k} 3,{ }^{*} \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 5^{*}$, repeat from * to * to the last 14 sts, p1, k3, *p1, k1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times.
Row 16: Work as Row 14.
Row 17: *K1, p1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times, k1, *k2tog, yarn over, k1, yarn over, k2tog tbl, p1*, repeat from * to * to the last 16 sts, k2tog, yarn over, k1, yarn over, k2tog tbl, k1, *p1, k1*, repeat from * to * a total of 5 times.
Row 18: Work as Row 12.
Row 11-18 form the pattern. Repeat these rows 16 more times.
Then repeat Row 1-2 so there are a total of 9 rows of k1, p1 ribbing. Bind off on the 10th row of ribbing.
Press the towel to make it smooth and even. Weave in all ends.

## MODEL B:

Cast on 55 sts on UK size $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ ( 3 mm ) needles.
Row 1-12: Knit.
Row 13: K12, *p1, k5*, repeat from * to * to the last 7 sts, k7.
Row 14: K7, *p5, k1*, repeat from * to * to the last 6 sts, k6.
Row 15: K7, *yarn over, k2tog tbl, p1, k2tog, yarn over, k1*, repeat from * to * to the last 6 sts, k6.
Row 16: K7, p2, *k1, p5*, repeat from * to * to the last 10 sts, k1, p2, k7.
Row 17: K9, *p1, k5*, repeat from * to * to the last 10 sts, p1, k9.
Row 18: Work as Row 16.
Row 19: K7, *k2tog, yarn over, k1, yarn over, k2tog tbl, p1*, repeat from * to * to the last 12 sts, k2tog, yarn over, k1, yarn over,
k2tog tbl, k7.
Row 20: Work as Row 14.
Repeat Row 13-20 seven more times
Then knit 11 rows. Bind off knit-wise.
Press the towel to make it smooth and even. Weave in all ends.

A: approx. $40 \times 54 \mathrm{~cm}$
B: approx. $26 \times 26 \mathrm{~cm}$

## YARN

Colourful Fraya
100\% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g}=170 \mathrm{~m}$
YARDAGE
A: 100 g
B: 50 g
GAUGE
22 sts and 30 rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## SUGGESTED NEEDLE SIZE

UK size $\mathrm{2}^{1 ⁄ 2}$ ( 3 mm )

Please note: The needle sizes given above are only suggestions. The size of the needles you need depends on your personal gauge. If you knit firmly you might need a large needle size, if you knit loosely you might need a smaller needle size.
